COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION TO CLOSE JANUARY 16 AND 20

The Commission will be closed on Monday, January 16 in honor of Martin Luther King's birthday, and on Friday, January 20 in honor of the inauguration of the President of the United States.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DENIS C. TSEKLENIS ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on December 15, 1988 Judge James C. Paine entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Default against Denis C. Tseklenis. Tseklenis failed to file an amended answer after his original, one sentence answer was stricken because it did not comply with the Federal Rules of Civil Procedures.

Tseklenis was enjoined from violating certain registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The other four defendants, Edward J. Roy, Reinhard Mueller, James A. Sharon, and Ralph Vaughn, were previously enjoined from violating the same provisions, after consenting to the permanent injunctive relief without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint.

The Complaint alleged that defendants violated antifraud provisions of the securities laws by engaging in a complex scheme to manipulate the market for certain securities, creating the illusion of active and liquid markets for the securities. It also alleged that defendants engaged in activities which violated the registration provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Edward J. Roy, et al., USDC SDFL, Civil Action No. 87-2300-Civ.-Paine). (LR-11959)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANCO ESPANOL CENTRAL DE CREDITO, S.A.

An order has been issued exempting Banco Espanol Central de Credito, S.A. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with its proposed issuance of equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-16735 - Jan. 3)

PW PRIVATE CAPITAL TECHNOLOGY FUND, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by PW Private Capital Technology Fund, L.P. (the Partnership), PaineWebber Technology Management, L.P., and PaineWebber Development Corporation (collectively, Applicants), for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(19) and 2(a)(3)(D) of the Investment Company Act that (1) the Independent General Partners will not be deemed "interested persons" of Applicants solely by reason of serving as general partners of the Partnership, and (2) the Limited Partners owning less than five percent of limited partnership interests in the Partnership will not be deemed "affiliated persons" of other partners or the Partnership solely by reason of their status as Limited Partners. (Rel. IC-16736 - Jan. 4)

NATIONAL RURAL UTILITIES COOPERATIVE FINANCE CORPORATION

An order has been issued on an application filed on behalf of the National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation and certain trusts (Trusts) granting an exemption from all provisions of the Investment Company Act other than Sections 26 (with certain exceptions), 36, 37 and (to the extent necessary to implement the foregoing Sections) 38 through 53 thereof in connection with the issuance of certificates by the Trusts to Applicant and their subsequent resale to the public by Applicant. (Rel. IC-16737 - Jan. 4)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by The Columbia Gas System Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., Columbia Gas of New York, Inc., Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., Commonwealth Gas Pipeline Corporation, Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc., Commonwealth Propane, Inc., and Columbia Gas System Service Corporation, whereby Columbia will increase the level of short and long-term intrasystem financing for its subsidiaries. Jurisdiction has been reserved over certain matters. (Rel. 35-24800 Dec. 30, 1988)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of the following stock exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Pacific Stock Exchange - 11 issues. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE/ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Securities Trust Company filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b- (SR-MSTC-88-8) to enhance its File Transmission Service (FTS) by allowing Depositor Delivery Instructions (DDI) to be transmitted through FTS. The Commission is publishing this notice and order to solicit comment on the proposal and to approve it on temporary basis through March 31, 1989. (Rel. 34-26418)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-31) to institute guidelines to govern stock trading after its circuit breaker and sidecar provisions have gone into effect. (Rel. 34-26419); and The MF Clearing Corporation (SR-MBS-88-15) to impose a schedule of penalties on Participants who fail to make timely payment of their debit balances. (Rel. 34-26421)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-Amex-88-33) will increase certain option and floor fees. The fee increases are scheduled to take effect in two phases - the initial fee increase occurred on January 1, 1989, while the second phase of the proposed fee increase is scheduled to take effect January 1, 1990.
