COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

FOIA APPEAL OF ST. PAUL COMPANIES

The General Counsel sent a letter to Ward C. Schendel, on behalf of the St. Paul Companies, reversing in part and affirming in part the Freedom of Information Act Officer's decision to withhold certain information relating to Ivan F. Boesky's trading activity, and remanding to the FOIA Office for further action. The General Counsel determined that FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 USC 552(b)(7)(A), 17 CFR 200.80(b)(5), was improperly applied to information made public by Commission complaints in SEC v. Boesky, 86 Civ. 8767 (SDNY) and SEC v. Siegel, 87 Civ. 0963 (SDNY). The General Counsel provided the Boesky and Siegel complaints to the requester, remanded the case to the FOIA Office to review documents relating to nonpublic trading dates relating to companies the names of which were made public in the complaints to determine whether any other exemption applies, affirmed the FOIA Officer's determination as it related to the remaining requested information under FOIA Exemption 7(A), and informed the requester that information regarding dates that Boesky's trading had an impact on stock prices does not exist in Commission records. ORDER GRANTING ACCESS, IN PART, TO WILLIAM C. HOU

The General Counsel sent a letter to William C. Hou, in response to his request under the Freedom of Information Act granting access to all but the specific confidential portions of the Exhibits to a Form 10-Q filed for the quarter ending June 30, 1988 by Geostar Corporation. The Commission issued an order on January 19, 1989, under Securities Exchange Act Rule 24b-2, granting confidential treatment to this information. The confidential portions of the Exhibits consist of specific pricing information, manufacturing schedules, and intricate details about the satellites to be produced for Geostar. The General Counsel determined that this confidential information is exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 4, 5 USC 552(b)(4), which protects matters that are "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged and confidential." ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

GEORGE M. WOZNIAK SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Gary M. Wozniak who, from April 1986 to August 1987, was a registered representative associated with a Michigan broker-dealer registered with the Commission. Simultaneously, Wozniak submitted an Offer of Settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by those proceedings.

Wozniak consented to the Order which finds that he was permanently enjoined from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws [SEC v. Gary M. Wozniak, EDMI, Southern Division, Case No. 87-60283AA] and was convicted, upon a plea of guilty, to two counts of mail fraud in violation of Section 1341 of Title 18, U.S. Code [U.S. v. Gary Wozniak, EDMI, Southern Division, Case No. 87-80688]. The Commission permanently barred Wozniak from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-26459)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST HUNTER MACK BELTON

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that in December 1988 U.S. District Judge George C. Carr, Middle District of Florida, entered a final judgment of permanent injunction by default, order directing an accounting and other relief against Hunter Mack Belton of Orlando, Florida. The final judgment enjoins Belton from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, from offering and selling unregistered securities, and from effecting transactions in securities while not registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer. The Complaint, filed on December 22, 1987, alleges that the defendants operated as unregistered broker-dealers and sold unregistered securities, in the form of interests in a Brazilian entity known as a limitada, which purportedly operated a gold mine in Brazil. The defendants made misrepresentations concerning, among other things, the status of the gold mining operations, the value of the limitada's assets, and the use of the proceeds invested. An accounting is due from Belton by February 27, 1989. (SEC v. Hunter Mack Belton, Civil Action No. 87-1890-CIV-T-13C, MDFL). (LR-11967)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE ALGER AMERICAN FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Alger American Fund and certain life insurance companies and their variable life insurance separate accounts investing in the Fund (collectively, Applicants), for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act to permit mixed and shared funding. (Rel. IC-16767 - Jan. 23)

WNC HOUSING TAX CREDIT FUND, L.P.,

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by WNC Housing Tax Credit Fund, L.P. (the Partnership) and its managing general partner, WNC Resources, Inc., for an order exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-16768 - Jan. 23)

THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Prudential Insurance Company of America, The Prudential Individual Variable Contract Account, and Pruco Securities Corporation (collectively, Applicants), for an order, under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2)(c), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), and 27(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1, to permit Applicants to issue variable annuity contracts providing for a recapturable bonus equal to 1% of certain purchase payments and to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Account. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA FUELS, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Columbia Fuels, Inc. and its parent company, Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to finance the purchase of Alabama's nuclear fuel in the approximate amount of up to \$100 million. (Rel. 35-24807 - Jan. 24)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-89-2) that became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendment to Section 2 of Schedule A to the NASD By-Laws increases from \$500 to \$1,500 the assessment against each applicant for NASD membership. (Rel. 34-26464)
