CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST PAUL A. BILZERIAN, DAVID A. TALLANT, BILZERIAN AND MACK ASSOCIATES, HPC ACQUISITION CORPORATION, EDWARD J. DEBARTOLO, SR., WILLIAM D. MOSES AND RICHARD S. SOKOLOV

The Commission filed an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Paul A. Bilzerian, David A. Tallant, Bilzerian and Mack Associates, HPC Acquisition Corporation, Edward J. DeBartolo, Sr., William D. Moses and Richard S. Sokolov seeking to enjoin Bilzerian from violating Sections 7(c), 7(f), 9(a)(2), 10(b), 13(d), 14(d), 14(e) and 17(a)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and rules thereunder, in connection with the securities of seven companies. The Commission is seeking injunctions against Tallant, DeBartolo, Sr., Moses and Sokolov from violating Sections 10(b), 13(d), 14(d) and 14(e) of the Exchange Act and rules thereunder. Simultaneously, DeBartolo, Sr., Moses and Sokolov consented to the entry of injunctions, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint. DeBartolo, Sr. and Moses also consented to disgorge \$2,748,362 and \$205,850, respectively, representing profits from Cluett Peabody and Hammermill Paper Co., and Moses agreed to pay an ITSA penalty of \$129,375 from his Hammermill purchases.

The Commission also filed an application for an order and a motion for expedited discovery against Bilzerian. (SEC v. Paul A. Bilzerian, David A. Tallant, Bilzerian and Mack Associates, HPC Acquisition Corporation, Edward J. DeBartolo, Sr., William D. Moses and Richard S. Sokolov, Civil Action No. 89-1854, D.D.C., June 29, 1989) (LR-12144)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JERRY LAMPLEY, TOM ELLZEY, JOHN MCCURDY, SR. AND DENNIS PILLER SENTENCED

On June 26 and 27, Jerry Lampley, Tom Ellzey, John McCurdy, Sr., and Dennis Piller were sentenced by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Mississippi pursuant to guilty pleas to one count of mail fraud, one count of securities fraud, and one count of sale of unregistered securities each. The pleas related to material misrepresentations and omissions made in connection with the sale and offer for sale of unregistered oil and gas working interests asserted in the Commission's action in SEC v. Petro-Serve, Ltd., et al., filed on July 23, 1987.

Lampley received consecutive prison sentences of five and four years on the first two counts, five years probation on the third count, and was ordered to pay restitution of \$5 million. Ellzey received a sentence of three years in prison on the first count and five years probation on the second and third counts, and was ordered to pay restitution of \$164,000. McCurdy was sentenced to five years in prison on the first count and five years probation on the second and third counts, and was ordered to pay restitution of \$1 million. Piller received consecutive prison terms of five and two years on the first two counts, five years probation on the third count, and was ordered to pay restitution of \$1 million. (U.S. v. (NCRS) under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 for an order granting an exemption from the provisions of Section 17(a) to permit the Partnership to sell and NCRS to acquire certain securities of National Car Rental System, Inc. CANADA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 24 to request a hearing on an application by Canada Life Insurance Company of America, Canada Life Insurance Company of America Variable Annuity Account 1 (Account), and Canada Life of America Financial Services, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the Account in connection with the issuance of certain flexible premium variable deferred annuity contracts. ND TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 24 to request a hearing on an application by ND Tax-Free Fund, Inc., and ND Capital, Inc. (Applicants) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 exempting Applicants from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 to the extent necessary to impose a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-89-3) that amends the MSRB's Arbitration Code to require that a dealer, within 20 days after receipt of an arbitration award against it, either pay the award or deposit the award amount in an escrow account; or provide the prevailing party with an irrevocable standby letter of credit. Publication of the rule change is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 26. (Rel. 34-26953)
