COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN RUDER APPLAUDS SELECTION OF RICHARD BREEDEN

The Commission today published a statement from David S. Ruder, Chairman of the Commission, applauding the nomination of Richard Breedon as the next Chairman of the Securities and Exchange Commission. The statement was issued yesterday. (Press Release 89-61)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST DOUGLAS C. ADAMS, OTHERS

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings against Douglas C. Adams, John Geanoulis, and William A. Fox, Jr. Simultaneously, and pursuant to Offers of Settlement from each, the Commission, based on Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction [SEC v. John Peter Galanis, et al., Civil Action No. C 89 2529 FMS, NDCA; LR-12154] and on criminal convictions of Adams and Geanoulis, barred Adams, Geanoulis, and Fox from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company, or municipal securities dealer. SECURITY FIRST LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

EUA COGENEX CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 5 to request a hearing on a proposal by EUA Cogenex Corporation, subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, to issue and sell, through December 31, 1989, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding under Rule 50(a)(5), up to \$25 million aggregate principal amount of secured or unsecured notes (Notes) and/or first mortgage bonds (Bonds), the net proceeds of which will be applied to pay or reduce short-term borrowings from banks, to pay or reduce short-term loans from EUA, for the acquisition of tangible assets of Cogenex and for general corporate purposes. Cogenex has been authorized to begin negotiating terms of the Notes and Bonds with institutional investors, or to engage a placement agent to negotiate and place the Notes and Bonds with institutional purchasers.
