## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

### COMMISSION WILL BE CLOSED NOVEMBER 10

The Commission will be closed on Friday, November 10; Veteran's Day is a federal holiday. Publication of the Digest will resume on Monday, November 13.

### POSSIBLE FEE INCREASE

Registrants and their representatives should be aware that sections of both authorization and appropriation legislation pending before Congress would, once signed into law, immediately amend current statutes regarding the percentage used to calculate filing fees. Under H.R. 3299, if adopted, the fees paid pursuant to Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 13(e)(3) and 14(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 would be equal to 1/40th of 1% rather than the current 1/50th of 1%. S.1712 would raise only the fee under Section 6(b) to 1/40th of 1%. These fee changes will become effective upon enactment of either legislative proposal, and any filing not in compliance may not be accepted. The Commission will monitor these legislative initiatives and make an immediate announcement once either bill is signed into law.

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### GREENWICH CAPITAL ACCEPTANCE, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Greenwich Capital Acceptance, Inc. (Applicant), as depositor of Greenwich CMO Trusts II-VI and similar trusts (the Trusts) to be established by Applicant, to issue and sell mortgage-backed bonds. Applicant requests a conditional order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the Trusts' issuance of mortgage-backed bonds and election of REMIC status, and Applicant's sale of residual interests in the Trusts. ### THE MINNESOTA MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application by Minnesota Mutual Life Insurance Company, Minnesota Mutual Variable Life Account, and MIMLIC Sales Corporation for an order granting exemptions from Section 27(f) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 27f-1 and 6e-2(b)(13)(viii) (C) to permit notices of withdrawal rights (free look rights) under certain scheduled premium variable life insurance policies to contain information comparable to that required by Form N-27I-2 but not in the exact format required by that Form, and to permit those free look notices to be hand-delivered to contract owners rather than delivered by way of first class mail. ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA; NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24980, dated November 2: PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA (PSO) - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, and by PSO's mining subsidiary, Ash Creek Mining Company, wherein PSO seeks to extend its authorization to finance Ash Creek through December 31, 1991 in the maximum principal amount of \$4 million outstanding at any one time;

NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED (NEEI) - subsidiary of New England Electric System, to contribute up to \$60 million to its partnership with Samedan Oil Corporation, subsidiary of Noble Affiliates, Inc., a nonaffiliate company, during the years 1990 and 1991 for exploration and development of oil and gas prospects initiated by the partnership prior to December 31, 1986; and NEEI will dispose of its interests in New England Collier Company (NECCO), a joint venture formed between NEEI and Keystone Shipping Co. to construct, own, and operate a coal collier to deliver coal to New England Power Company by, among other things, renegotiating and acquiring a \$10 million note from Keystone to replace a \$10 million note of NECCO which it now holds.
