ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON CABOT MONEY MANAGEMENT, INC. AND ROBERT T. LUTTS

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Cabot Money Management, Inc. and its president, Robert T. Lutts. The Order alleges that Cabot and Lutts violated Section 206 of the Advisers Act and Rules 206(4)-1(a)(2) and 206(4)-1(a)(5) by publishing materially false and misleading statements in promotional materials distributed to clients and prospective clients. These statements concerned account performance, comparisons with other investment advisers and market indexes, and improper use of model portfolios. Cabot and Lutts consented to the Order censuring them, prohibiting them from soliciting or accepting the business of new clients for 45 days, and requiring Lutts to notify Cabot's clients of the Commission's action. In addition, Cabot and Lutts agreed to remedial undertakings specified in the Commission's Order. (Rel. IA-1063)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST KELLY N. TRIMBLE

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Kelly N. Trimble, of Salt Lake City, Utah. Trimble is currently employed as a sales agent by Warren & Brown Assoc. Inc., a Salt Lake City broker-dealer.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Trimble: (1) aided and abetted antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act by John Worthen, of Salt Lake City, in connection with a scheme to manipulate the stock of Western Pacific Technology Inc.; (2) acted as a nominee holder of a brokerage account used for the benefit of Worthen's manipulative scheme and acted as a sales agent for other nominee brokerage accounts; and (3) aided and abetted violations of the Section 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 17a-3(9) in that nominee brokerage accounts serviced by Trimble did not reflect the true beneficial owner of the account.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FREEDOM INVESTMENT TRUST II

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Freedom Investment Trust II, an open-end management investment company, for an order exempting it from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit its two existing series of shares and all future series of shares to assess a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of its shares. DEAN WITTER CMO INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Dean Witter CMO Inc. for an order exempting it and certain trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the proposed issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and equity interests in such trusts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24354, dated March 26: National Fuel Gas Company - a registered holding company. On March 9, 1987, National's Board of Directors declared a two-for-one split of National's common stock for the purpose of increasing market liquidity of the common stock and to make it more readily accessible to investors. National proposes, effective upon the consummation of the stock split, to double the aggregate number of shares of Common Stock subject to the National Fuel Gas Company 1983 Incentive Stock Option Plan and the National Fuel Gas Company 1984 Stock Plan, to 1.1 million shares. The individual limits with respect to both plans also will be doubled to 110,000 shares. Consequently, National proposes to double the number of such shares subject to outstanding options, stock appreciation rights and restricted stock granted pursuant to such plans, to halve the exercise price of outstanding options and stock appreciation base prices, and to halve the price for purposes of calculating the value of stock appreciation rights.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-87-10) that would amend Section 59 of its Uniform Practice Code. The amendment would require buy-ins for cash or guaranteed delivery for NASDAQ securities, where the buyer is a customer other than another NASD member, upon the failure of the clearing corporation to effect delivery under a buy-in notice. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 6. (Rel. 34-24297)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CORRECTION RE AMERICAN SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL CORPORATION

A corrected notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 24 to request a hearing on an application by American Southwest Finance Co., Inc. under Section 310 (b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The original notice, published in the March 23 News Digest, should have stated the application was filed on behalf of American Southwest Finance Co., Inc. instead of American Southwest Financial Corporation. The application declared that the trusteeship of the Valley National Bank of Arizona under an indenture and supplements thereto is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under the indenture and indenture supplements. The indenture is dated October 1, 1984 and the securities outstanding under the indenture and indenture supplements are various issues of mortgage-collateralized bonds. (Rel. TI-2076A)
