CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SUMMARY JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST MASON BENSON

The Commission announced that on April 8 Judge Pierre N. Leval, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, rendered a summary judgment in favor of the Commission against Mason Benson. The court permanently enjoined Benson from violation of the antifraud provisions and the rule against lying to auditors under the securities laws, and it ordered him to disgorge \$502,202.

The Court found that the Commission had fully proved its contentions that Benson, former chief executive officer of Empire of Carolina, had systematically misappropriated funds from Empire. Among other things, Benson had required kickbacks from outside sales representatives and had made Empire's internal employees file false expense claims and remit the proceeds to Benson.

Benson was sentenced on March 11 to a year and a day in prison after pleading guilty to federal tax evasion and securities violation counts arising out of the Commission's investigation of this matter. (SEC v. Mason Benson, SDNY, Docket No. 84 Civ. 2263, PNL). (LR-11401)

MORLEY P. THOMPSON RESTRAINED

The Commission announced on April 16 that Chief Judge Carl B. Rubin of the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio has entered a Stipulation and Final Order restraining Morley P. Thompson, former Chief Executive Officer and President of Baldwin-United Corp. from violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and related Rule 10b-5 and Section 13(a). Thompson consented to the court order without admitting or denying any of the allegations of the Commission's complaint which was filed September 26, 1985. (SEC v Baldwin-United Corp., et al., USDC SDOH, Civil Action No. C-1-85-1581). (LR-11404)

COMPLAINT NAMES REPUBLIC RESOURCES, INC.

The Commission announced that on April 17 it filed an injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Republic Resources, Inc. (Republic) of Newport Beach, California. The Commission in its complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the federal securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Republic, as part of continuing violative conduct over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended October 31, 1986 and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended January 31, 1987. The Commission requests that the Court order Republic to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin Republic from further violations of the reporting provisions of the federal securities laws. (SEC v. Republic Resources, Inc.; USDC for the District of Columbia, Civil Action No. 87-1065) (LR-11406)

KEYSTONE AMERICA EQUITY INCOME FUND

An order has been issued granting Keystone America Equity Income Fund, Keystone America Government Securities Fund, Keystone America Investment Grade Bond Fund, Keystone America High Yield Bond Fund, Keystone America Money Market Fund, Keystone America Tax Free Income Fund and Keystone America Tax Free Money Market Fund (Applicants) exemptions from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1 to permit the assessment and waiver of a contingent deferred sales load, and approving certain offers of exchange. FRANKLIN TAX-ADVANTAGED HIGH YIELD SECURITIES FUND (A CALIFORNIA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by Franklin Tax-Advantaged High Yield Securities Fund (A California Limited Partnership) and Franklin Tax-Advantaged U.S. Government Securities Fund (A California Limited Partnership) (Applicants or Partnerships), registered open-end, diversified, management investment companies, for an order declaring that the independent Managing General Partners of the Partnerships are not "interested persons", within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act, of their respective Partnerships, their corporate Non-Managing General Partners, their investment adviser, and/or their principal underwriter, solely by reason of their status as general partners of the Partnerships. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY; SOUTHERN ELECTRIC GENERATING COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24364, dated April 2: Jersey Central Power and Light Company - subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to issue a secured note for up to \$2.8 million, at an annual interest rate of 7.8%, in order to finance the cash purchase of Jersey Central's headquarters land and buildings, which it currently occupies under a lease from Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company. The Note will be secured by a mortgage on the land and buildings, will be payable in installments over five years, and will be prepayable from time-to-time at various premiums above the amount of such prepayment; Southern Electric Generating Company (SEGCO) - an its parents, Alabama Power Company and Georgia Power Company, to arrange refunding for up to \$8.6 million of pollution control revenue bonds. Alabama and Georgia will directly and indirectly guarantee SEGCO's performance under the financing agreement.
