COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

WEEKLY CALENDAR

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM RODMAN INDICTED

The New York Regional Office and Rudolph W. Giuliani, U.S. Attorney for the Southern District of New York, announced that on April 8 William Rodman was indicted by a federal grand jury on charges of manipulating three over-the-counter stocks. The three-count indictment charges Rodman with conspiracy, securities and wire fraud.

According to the indictment, Rodman conspired to artificially manipulate the prices of Memory Metals, Inc., Memory Protection Devices, Inc., and Intravision, Inc. to artificially high levels and then sell for a profit at the inflated prices. It is alleged that Rodman and his co-conspirators, in order to create the illusion of widespread ownership and interest in the stocks, effected purchases and sales through more than 100 accounts at at least 35 broker-dealers. Among the manipulative devices used in effecting these transactions were wash sales, matched orders, and undisclosed nominee accounts.

If convicted, Rodman faces maximum penalties of 15 years imprisonment and a \$750,000 fine. (U.S. v. William Rodman, et al., 87 Cr. 292 USDC SDNY). (LR-11416)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE GATEWAY TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 19 to request a hearing on an application by The Gateway Trust for an order permitting quarterly distributions of long-term capital gains from certain option transactions. (Rel. IC-15703 - April 24)

DEAN WITTER CMO INC.

An order has been issued exempting Dean Witter CMO Inc. and certain trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the proposed issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and equity interests in such trusts. (Rel. IC-15704 - April 27)

MORGAN STANLEY GROUP INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Morgan Stanley Group Inc. and its subsidiary, Morgan Stanley Capital I Inc., amending an existing order (Rel. IC-15548, January 20, 1987) to permit the subsidiary and certain trusts that it has formed or may form to issue variable and floating rate mortgage-backed securities and the subsidiary to sell beneficial ownership interest in such trusts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CNG PRODUCING COMPANY; EASTERN EDISON COMPANY
GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24376, dated April 23: CNG Producing Company (Producing) - and CNG Development Company, subsidiaries of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, to increase from \$475,000 to a maximum of \$1,600,000 the amount of a letter of credit which Producing was authorized to obtain by orders dated October 1, 1985 (Rel. 35-23848) and May 7, 1986 (Rel. 35-24090); Eastern Edison Company - subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, to issue and sell in one or more series from time to time under competitive bidding not in excess of \$100 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage and collateral trust bonds; and Georgia Power Company - subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell, on or before December 31, 1988, first mortgage bonds, preferred stock, and pollution control revenue bonds in an aggregate amount up to \$850 million in any combination of issuance. Georgia may use the proceeds of the sale of such securities, among other purposes, for the refunding of certain series of Georgia's outstanding first mortgage bonds, preferred stock, or pollution control revenue bonds. Georgia may amend to request an exception from Rule 50, but will otherwise comply with competitive bidding requirements.

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of the specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Midwest Stock Exchange - two issues. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by The Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-86-39) to extend the maximum duration of non-equity options permits from three to four years. (Rel. 34-24391)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF INDIANA, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 18 to request a hearing on an application by General Telephone Company of Indiana, Inc., an Indiana corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under an indenture dated July 1, 1968 between General Telephone Company of Ohio and the Bank, as supplemented and amended by a First Supplemental Indenture and Indenture of Assumption dated March 31, 1987 between General Telephone and the Bank, which indenture is qualified under the Act, and an indenture dated August 1, 1966 which is not qualified under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under any of these indentures.
