RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

REPROPOSAL OF REVISED RULE 701, NEW TEMPORARY RULES 702 AND 703, AND A REVISED FORM 701

The Commission is reproposing for comment a revised Rule 701, new temporary Rules 702 and 703, and a revised Form 701 to provide an exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 for offers and sales of securities pursuant to employee benefit plans or compensation contracts of issuers that are not subject to the reporting requirements of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

TWO ALTERNATIVE VERSIONS OF NEW RULE 433 PROPOSED FOR COMMENT

The Commission is proposing for comment two alternative versions of a new Rule 433 which would allow, if certain conditions are met, the prospectus meeting the requirements of Section 10(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (final prospectus) to be sent to an investor no later than five business days following the date a confirmation of sale is sent to an investor in a firm commitment offering of securities sold for cash.

RICHARD J. SHEEHAN APPOINTED ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

He began his career with the firm of Armstrong, Teasdale, Kramer & Vaughan until he resigned from that partnership in 1973 to head the litigation department of the fledgling firm of Susman, Stern, Heifetz, Lurie & Sheehan.

PIONEER BOND FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by Pioneer Bond Fund, Pioneer Fund, Pioneer II, Pioneer Three, Pioneer Municipal Bond Fund, Pioneer Money Market Trust (Funds), and The Pioneer Group, Inc. (Underwriter) on behalf of all existing and subsequently created series of the Funds and any other investment company or series which will be distributed by the Underwriter, amending an existing order (Rel. IC-14956, February 25, 1986) to approve a modification in the sales charge applicable to their current exchange offers. (Rel. IC-15901 - July 29)

COMMUNITY PROGRAM LOAN TRUST NO. 1987 A

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by Webster & Sheffield, as attorneys on behalf of a trust to be formed, the Community Program Loan Trust No. 1987 A (Trust) in connection with the Federal government's pilot loan asset sale program. The application requests an order conditionally exempting the Trust from all provisions of the Act other than Sections 26 (with certain exceptions), 36, 37, and (to the extent necessary to implement the foregoing sections) 38 through 53 thereof in connection with the issuance of senior and subordinated bonds and senior and junior certificates of beneficial interest collateralized by certain loans originated by the Department of Agriculture, Farmers Home Administration. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change by filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-29) to introduce a new NASDAQ Workstation service on a pilot basis from July 31 to October 1, 1987. (Rel. 34-24749)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NYSE-87-22) adopts a flat fee for any listed company that changes its state of incorporation or forms a holding company that replaces the listed company. (Rel. 34-24753)
