ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STOP ORDER ENTERED AGAINST MOHAVE MINERALS, INC.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings and simultaneously entered findings and a stop order suspending the effectiveness of two post-effective amendments filed on May 27 and October 3, 1986 by Mohave Minerals, Inc. Mohave is a Colorado corporation headquartered in Westport, Connecticut. Mohave's sole significant asset is a right of first refusal to participate in any joint venture to manufacturer, in Monterrey, Mexico, products developed from a new heating and cooling technology. The Commission entered the stop order following an offer of settlement submitted by Mohave. In that settlement offer, Mohave neither admitted nor denied the Commission's findings that its post-effective amendments omitted to state material facts necessary to make the statements made therein not misleading. Specifically, Mohave's post-effective amendments failed to disclose that the corporation from which Mohave purchased the right of first refusal did not own the Mexican rights to the heating and cooling technology. OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED FROM WALSH, GREENWOOD & CO. AND TIMOTHY B. BARBA

In administrative proceedings ordered under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Walsh, Greenwood & Co. (Registrant), a registered New York City broker-dealer, and one of its general partners, Timothy B. Barba, submitted Offers of Settlement which the Commission accepted. Registrant and Barba, without admitting or denying the allegations, allowed the Commission to find that from about August 1985 to January 1986, Registrant, aided and abetted by Barba, failed to: maintain the minimum net capital required; comply with various provisions of the customer protection rule in that Registrant pledged customers' fully-paid and excess margin securities as collateral for bank loans made to Registrant; maintain accurate books and records; and comply with various provisions of the financial and supplemental reporting requirements.

Registrant consented to a censure and agreed to comply with certain undertakings designed to prevent the recurrence of similar violations. A certified public accountant will review Registrant's compliance with its undertakings. Barba consented to a bar, with the right to reapply after three years, from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer in any supervisory capacity. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DOY L. DANIELS, JR. AND D.L. DANIELS & CO. ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on August 17 Judge Julia S. Gibbons, Western District of Tennessee, entered an Order of Preliminary Injunction against Doy L. Daniels, Jr. and Doy L. Daniels, Jr., doing business as D.L. Daniels & Co. The Order, entered following the consent of the defendants, enjoins them from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Order also freezes all of their assets and requires them to provide an accounting to the Court.

The complaint alleged that as part of a fraudulent scheme, defendants offered and sold securities to investors, requiring them to make their checks payable to D.L. Daniels & Co. for the purchase of securities. Thereafter, defendants either delayed execution of the transactions for extensive periods or failed to process the orders. The complaint further alleges that the defendants misappropriated hundreds of thousands of dollars in connection with failing to process the orders and caused an uncalculated amount of customer losses due to the delayed processing of orders. (SEC v. Doy L. Daniels, Jr., et al., WDTN, Civil Action No. 87-2575-GB). (LR-11522)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

JOHN P. ROBERTS INDICTED

The U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of Georgia and the Atlanta Regional Office announced that on August 6 John P. Roberts of Marietta, Georgia was indicted on four counts of fraud under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 and nine counts of mail fraud. The indictment alleges, among other things, that Roberts falsely represented to clients that funds would be invested in high grade securities with yields of 12% to 20%, that most of his clients received a return on their investment in excess of 20 percent, and that the clients' funds would be returned to the client within ten days of the clients' request. The indictment further alleges that Roberts converted clients' funds to his own use.

If convicted on these charges, Roberts faces a maximum jail term of 65 years, a fine of \$500,000, and restitution of \$174,000. (U.S. v. John P. Roberts, CR 87-300-A, USDC NDGA). (LR-11521)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EATON VANCE CORPORATE HIGH INCOME DOLLAR FUND, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 14 to request a hearing on an application by Eaton Vance Corporate High Income Dollar Fund, L.P. and Eaton Vance U.S. Government Income Dollar Fund, L.P. for an order declaring that the present and future individual Managing General Partners of each limited partnership shall not be deemed "interested persons" solely due to their status as partners of each limited partnership. HIDDEN STRENGTH FUNDS; GLOBAL CAPITAL INVESTORS CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 10 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hidden Strength Funds (Trust), a Massachusetts business trust registered as an open-end, diversified, management investment company, and Global Capital Investors Corporation, the principal underwriter of the Trust, requesting an order approving certain offers of exchange to be made on a basis other than the relative net asset values of the shares to be exchanged. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Louisiana Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend its nuclear fuel leasing agreement, and to consent to a related credit agreement. (Rel. 35-24444 - Aug. 21)

DELISTING GRANTED

Orders have been issued granting the applications of the New York Stock Exchange to strike the 3-1/2% cumulative preferred stock of PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF INDIANA, INC., and the common stock, \$.20 par value, of SPECTRA-PHYSICS, INC. from listing and registration thereon. UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 14 to comment on the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in four issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 14 to comment on the application of GUARDIAN INDUSTRIES CORP. to withdraw the 11-3/4% notes, due March 1, 1993, from listing and registration on the New York Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24835)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-87-10) to facilitate trading of fungible options on the Major Market Index (XMI) on the European Options Exchange (EOE) providing for an information sharing agreement with the EOE relating to the trading of XMI options. (Rel. 34-24831); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-87-09) to facilitate trading of fungible options on the XMI on the EOE, enabling OCC to issue, clear, and settle XMI options traded on the EOE that are identical to and fungible with XMI options traded on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24832)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The MBS Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change which became effective under Section 19(b)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-MBSCC-87-7) requires participants to warrant that securities in a participant's proprietary account are not subject to other outstanding liens, states that MBS is acting as the participant's agent in filing claims for payment of principal and interest due, and amends the transfer account rules.
