CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST PHILIP C. CORDEK AND BAKER & GETTY DIVERSIFIED, INC.

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on September 17 Orders of Permanent Injunction were entered by U.S. District Court Judge George W. White, Northern District of Ohio, against Philip C. Cordek and Baker & Getty Diversified, Inc. The Orders restrain defendants from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and from acting as unregistered broker-dealers. Both consented to the Orders without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint.

The complaint alleged that from approximately December 1985 through December 1986, defendants sold common stock to approximately 20 investors, thereby raising at least \$2 million, by making material misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, that Cordek would effect the purchases of common stock for which investors had given him money when, in fact, he did not effect any of the transactions in securities. The complaint also alleged that the defendants acted as unregistered broker-dealers.

LAWRENCE CIANCHETTA ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on September 14 a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Order of Disgorgement by Consent was entered against Lawrence Cianchetta, also known as Larry Powers, formerly a registered representative and chief trader at Brooks, Hamburger, Satnick, Inc., formerly registered as a broker-dealer, enjoining him, following his consent and without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, from future violations of the registration, antifraud, and certain antimanipulative provisions of the securities laws. Powers was also ordered to pay \$150,000 in disgorgement.

The January 29 Complaint alleged various violations in connection with three offerings underwritten in 1983. All other defendants settled previously. (SEC v. Brooks, Weinger, Robbins & Leeds, Inc., 87 Civ. 593 RLS, USDC SDNY). (LR-11656)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EMPIRE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Empire Life Insurance Company, Composite Deferred Variable Account, and Murphey Favre, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual flexible premium deferred variable annuity contracts. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
