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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### SECRETARY OF COMMISSION TO RESIGN

The Commission today announced that John Wheeler will resign as Secretary to devote his full time to several non-profit projects. The resignation is effective May 23rd. (Press Release 86-27)

### PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION DENIED

The Commission voted to deny the relief requested by Metropolitan Investment Securities, Inc. (MIS), a Special Purpose Broker-Dealer (SPBD). MIS had requested that the Commission amend Schedule E of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s By-Laws to exempt SPBDs from certain of its requirements. The Commission denied the petition for reconsideration.

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### REGULATION A EXEMPTIONS OF FOUR UTAH ISSUERS TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

The Commission ordered that conditional exemptions from registration under Regulation A claimed by four Utah issuers be temporarily suspended under Rule 261(a) of Regulation A. Issuers are Brian V. Hanson Enterprises, Inc., Murray, Utah; Thomas J. Kearn Enterprises, Inc., Ramras, Inc., and Tobin F. Cowley, Inc., Salt Lake City. Each claimed the exemption for its common stock in a blind pool offering under Section 3(b) of the Securities Act of 1933.

The orders are based upon alleged failures to include within Forms 1-A, Part I-Notification and Part II-Offering Circulars, the identity of George I. Norman, III, an additional promoter and affiliate exercising control over the issuers, and sharing the power to vote securities. The orders regarding Kearn, Inc. and Hanson, Inc. also allege failure of Bion J. Kirk, a promoter and principal shareholder, to cooperate with the Commission's inquiry.

Interested persons may file with the Commission Secretary written requests for a hearing within 30 days after entry of the orders. If requests are received, the Commission sets a hearing on a permanent suspension. If no hearing is requested, the orders become permanent 30 days after entry. 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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### DONALD C. DECKER FOUND GUILTY

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on April 9 the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan found Donald C. Decker guilty of criminal contempt of an injunction entered against him in 1976 [SEC v. International Mining and Petroleum Company; Donald C. Decker, EDMI, CA No. 671903] based on a plea of nolo contendere. The 1976 injunction enjoined Decker from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The case was based on an application filed by the Commission which alleged that between March and August 1982, and in March 1984, Decker violated the 1976 injunction in the offer and sale of common stock of Equine America Corporation, an Arizona corporation. The Commission's application alleged that Decker sold unregistered Equine

common stock without an available exemption from registration and in this offer and sale made misrepresentations of material facts and omitted material facts concerning the application and use of proceeds from the sale of the securities, the financial condition of Equine, and the future market price of Equine.

A sentencing date will be set in the near future. (U.S. ex rel. SEC v. Donald C. Decker, EDMI, So. Div. Misc. No. 85-1254). (LR-11068)

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## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY;  
CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until May 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies under the same release: Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO) - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to acquire \$85,166,000 of its outstanding first mortgage bonds and 200,000 shares of its preferred stock, \$100 par value, and to provide funds for the defeasance of \$17,125,000 pollution control revenue bonds. In connection therewith, SWEPCO proposes to issue and sell up to \$125 million aggregate principal amount of first mortgage bonds; and Central Power and Light Company - subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell \$100 million of first mortgage bonds and sell \$100 million of debentures and to acquire, under a tender offer, up to \$85 million of its first mortgage bonds and \$100,742,000 of its debentures. 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## **TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES**

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CITICORP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 13 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of The United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures and two pooling and servicing agreements dated February 1, 1986, under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. The Trust Company is currently acting as trustee under the following four indentures dated: (1) February 15, 1972, involving the issuance of floating rate notes, due 1989; (2) March 15, 1977, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes; (3) August 25, 1977, involving the issuance of rising-rate notes, Series A; and (4) April 21, 1980, involving the issuance of various series of unsecured and unsubordinated notes. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
