The subject matter of the September 10 meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to issue an interpretative release concerning the application of Rule 10b-6 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to participants in secondary shelf distributions. The interpretive release would modify and clarify the extent to which Rule 10b-6 applies to shelf distribution participants and broker-dealers who sell shares on behalf of shelf distribution participants. (3) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment alternative amendments to Rule 2(e)(7) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the provision governing whether hearings in proceedings against professionals brought pursuant to Rule 2(e) shall be public or nonpublic. The proposed amendments relate to the current provision which provides that administrative proceedings instituted pursuant to Rule 2(e) shall be nonpublic unless the Commission otherwise orders. (4) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment Rule 6c-9 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. Rule 6c-9 would, under certain conditions, provide an exemption from that Act to permit a foreign bank or the bank's finance subsidiary to offer or sell its own debt securities or non-voting preferred stock in the United States without registering as an investment company. RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY AGENDA AND RULES SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW

The Commission published under the Regulatory Flexibility Act an agenda of open and anticipated rulemaking actions, a listing of rules scheduled for review in the next 12 months and a listing of completed rulemaking actions and reviews since the publication of the April 1986 agenda. The agenda, including the text of the individual

entries, will be published in the Federal Register by October 31 as part of a government-wide Unified Agenda of Federal Regulations.

The Commission seeks comment on the open or anticipated rulemaking actions, and on the rules scheduled for review. Persons wishing to submit written views should file three copies with Jonathan G. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HARTFORD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hartford Life Insurance Company; Hartford Life Insurance Company Separate Account Two (Account), registered under the Act as a unit investment trust; and Hartford Equity Sales Company, Inc. for an order granting exemption from certain provisions of the Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the Account, in connection with the issuance of certain flexible premium deferred combination fixed/variable annuity contracts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MIDDLE SOUTH ENERGY, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing System Energy Resources, Inc. (SERI), formerly Middle South Energy, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc. (MSU), a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to an aggregate principal amount of \$750 million of first mortgage bonds (Bonds) by means of negotiated public offering(s) or private placement(s) from time to time through August 31, 1988. The order also authorizes MSU and its subsidiaries, Arkansas Power & Light Company, Mississippi Power & Light Company, Louisiana Power & Light Company and New Orleans Public Services, Inc. to engage in an intra-system extension of credit. SERI is authorized to negotiate its initial Bond offering pursuant to an exception under Rule 50(a)(5) from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50. Jurisdiction is reserved with respect to the applicability of such requirements to subsequent Bond offerings. Jurisdiction is also reserved over the terms and conditions, and fees and expenses, related to the sale of each series of Bonds. (Rel. 35-24182 - September 3)

UTILICORP UNITED INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 29 to request a hearing on an application by UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp), an electric utility company, for an order pursuant to Section 3(b) and Rule 10 of the Act declaring that West Kootenay Power and Light Company, Limited (WKP), an electric utility organized under the laws of Canada, will not be a subsidiary of UtiliCorp for purposes of the Act following UtiliCorp's acquisition of 100% of the common shares of WKP. JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), an electric utility subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, and Energy Initiatives, Incorporated (EII), a wholly owned subsidiary of JCP&L. JCP&L proposes to (a) make cash capital contributions to EII aggregating \$5 million from time to time until

December 31, 1987 and (b) purchase from EII during such period up to an additional 10,000 shares of EII common stock (no par) for an aggregate purchase price of \$5 million provided that the total amount of such additional cash capital contributions and stock purchases would not exceed \$5 million. EII also requests to continue its authority for a total of \$2 million of secured and unsecured borrowings it may have outstanding at any one time through December 31, 1987. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved rule changes submitted by: the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. to establish eligibility criteria for market makers participating in a RAES six-month pilot in equity options (SR-CBOE-86-22) (Rel. 34-23591); and the Options Clearing Corporation (OCC) (SR-OCC-86-15) that enables Clearing Members to access OCC's Clearing Member Accounting and Control System by direct dial-up from a personal computer using multiple security features embedded in the hardware in place of a call-back feature. APPROVAL OF AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULES CHANGES

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. to operate RAES, its automatic execution system, as a six-month pilot in the Standard and Poor's 500 index option (SPX) (SR-CBOE86-14), and has accelerated approval of proposed rules changes to establish eligibility criteria for market makers participating in the RAES-SPX pilot (SR-CBOE-86-28) and to modify the definition of orders eligible for the RAES-SPX pilot to include marketable limit orders (SR-CBOE-86-29) (Rel. 34-23590).

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CHRYSLER FINANCIAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 24 to request a hearing on an application by Chrysler Financial Corporation (Company), a Michigan corporation, under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939.
