COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

WUNSCH AUCTION SYSTEMS EXEMPTED FROM REGISTRATION

By order dated February 20, the Commission granted an application filed by Wunsch Auction Systems, Inc. (WASI) for exemption from registration as a national securities exchange under Section 6 of the Securities Exchange Act for both WASI and WASI's computerized, "single-price" auction system, subject to terms and conditions set forth in the order. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

REDDINGTON INVESTMENTS SUED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on February 11, the Honorable Harry Lee Hudspeth, U.S. District Judge for the Western District of Texas (El Paso Division), entered Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction against Reddington Investments, Inc., Reddington Group, Inc., Reddington Securities, Inc. (Reddington Securities), Bradley A. Near (Near) and K. Alan Russell (Russell). The Final Judgments permanently enjoin each defendant from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws. The Final Judgments were entered pursuant to the defendants' consent without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint.

According to the complaint, the defendants fraudulently sold an estimated \$26 million in limited partnership interests to 610 investors during 1984-1986. The complaint alleges that offering documents used to sell the interests falsely stated that funds invested would be used only for the specific limited partnership for which the funds were raised, when, instead, funds were commingled and used for other purposes.

As part of the settlement agreements, Reddington Securities, a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, consented to the institution of an administrative proceeding revoking its registration with the Commission. Near and Russell, as part of their settlement agreements, consented to the institution of administrative proceedings barring them from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company or investment adviser with the right to reapply for association after four and three years, respectively. PILGRIM SHORT-TERM MULTI-MARKET INCOME FUND
