#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### CHAIRMAN BREEDEN TO ADDRESS THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF SAVINGS INSTITUTIONS

Chairman Breeden will address the Government Affairs session of the National Council of Savings Institutions on Wednesday, March 13, beginning at 9:15 a.m. in Ballroom II of the ANA (formerly the Westin) Hotel in Washington, D.C. Chairman Breeden will be available to meet with the press following his remarks from about 10:00 a.m. to about 10:15 a.m. in the Imperial Ballroom II.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

#### PROCEEDINGS SETTLED AGAINST OSCAR AYALA

The Commission announced the settlement of public administrative proceedings against Oscar Ayala, formerly a registered representative of The Robinson-Humphrey Company, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Shearson Lehman Hutton, Inc. The Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions bars Ayala from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer and is effective immediately.

In an earlier action, on June 28, 1990, Ayala, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint, consented to an Order of Permanent Injunction in the case of SEC v. Oscar Ayala, Civil Action No. 1:90-CV-1183-GET, in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division. The complaint alleged that Ayala engaged in fraudulent conduct by making unauthorized trades for many of his customers, persuaded many of his customers to give him funds for investments which Ayala never made and converted an amount in excess of \$2 million of his customers' funds to his private use and benefit. # MICHAEL TAYLOR SANCTIONED

The Commission announced on March 4, that it simultaneously instituted and settled an administrative proceeding against Michael S. Taylor, the former President of Mostel & Taylor Securities, Inc. (MTSI), a now-defunct registered broker-dealer located in New York City. Taylor consented to the issuance of an Order by the Commission that finds that from June 1988 to March 1989, Taylor aided and abetted MTSI's violations of Section 15(c) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 15c3-1 thereunder, in that

he caused MTSI to operate a securities business while it did not maintain sufficient net capital. Taylor consented to a 90 day suspension from association with various Commission regulated entities, and a bar from association in a supervisory or proprietary capacity with various Commission regulated entities with a right to reapply after two years. #### CORRECTION

The March 5th issue of the Digest reported that, in a public administrative proceeding, Benchmark International Investment Corporation and its president, David Paul Chiodo denied findings of violations. They consented without admitting or denying findings of violations to an Order making findings.

# COMPLAINT AGAINST VICTOR TEICHER AND OTHERS

On March 8, the New York Regional Office of the Commission announced the filing of a complaint seeking permanent injunctions against future violations of the federal securities laws against Victor Teicher (Teicher), a former arbitrageur, Ross S. Frankel (Frankel), a former corporate vice-president in the Domestic Arbitrage Department at Drexel Burnham Lambert, Inc. (Drexel) and two entities that Teicher controlled, Victor Teicher & Co., L.P. (Teicher & Co.) and Carmel Partners, L.P. (Carmel). The complaint also seeks disgorgement by Teicher, Teicher & Co., Carmel and Frankel of illegal trading profits, prejudgment interest on the disgorgement amounts and civil penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. # FINAL JUDGMENT RE ORTWIN HEIDER AND OTHERS

The Commission announced today that the Hon. Charles S. Haight, Jr., Judge, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, awarded final judgment of \$2,706,920 against certain unknown purchasers of Contel securities (Subject Defendants) to the Commission. The final judgment consists of disgorgement in the amount of \$676,730 and a three time civil penalty pursuant to the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988 (ITSFEA) in the amount of \$2,030,190. The amount of disgorgement to be paid by the Subject Defendants constitutes their illegal profits from the purchase of Contel securities in violation of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder.

The final judgment results from the Commission's pending civil injunctive action against certain individuals and entities whom it alleges purchased common stock of Contel Corporation (Contel) and call option contracts for the common stock of Contel while in possession of material nonpublic information concerning a merger between Contel and GTE Corporation (GTE) which was announced on July 12, 1990. In connection with this injunctive action, the Court awarded final judgment to the Commission against all defendants who failed to identify themselves and/or answer the Commission's complaint or amended complaint, filed on July 13, 1990 and July 23, 1990,

respectively. [SEC v. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### AMERICAN CAPITAL WORLD PORTFOLIO SERIES

A conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act has been issued on an application filed by American Capital World Portfolio Series, Inc. The order grants an exemption from provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit the applicant to invest in equity, warrants, and convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. # CNG TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal of CNG Transmission Corporation (Transmission) and The Peoples Natural Gas Company (Peoples), wholly owned subsidiary companies of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, for Peoples to exchange all of its natural gas properties within and around the North Summit Pool located in Fayette County, Pennsylvania for all of Transmission's natural gas properties within and around the Jacksonville Pool, located in Indiana County, Pennsylvania. # SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

## APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-90-58) that would amend Article III, Section 28(c) of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice so as to require an associated person to provide the following notice in writing: (1) to his or her employer prior to opening or placing an initial order in a securities account with another member; and (2) to the executing member of his or her association with the employer member. Publication of the order approving the proposed rule change is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of March 11. (Rel. 34-28945)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
