COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

NAME CHANGE

The Office of Applications & Reports Services (OARS) has changed its name to more accurately reflect its re-aligned functions. The new name is the OFFICE OF FILINGS, INFORMATION & CONSUMER SERVICES (FICS), effective immediately.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION ORDERED AGAINST PAUL BILZERIAN

On April 8, the Honorable Stanley S. Harris, U.S. District Judge for the District of Columbia, issued an Order of Partial Summary Judgment and Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction Against Defendant Paul A. Bilzerian (Bilzerian) in the above-entitled action. The Court found that Bilzerian had violated numerous provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the rules thereunder, including the antifraud provisions (§§ 10(b), 14(e), and Rule 10b-5); disclosure of beneficial ownership requirements (§ 13(d) and Rules 13d-1 and 13d-2); reporting and disclosure requirements with respect to tender offers (§ 14(d) and Rules 14d-3 and 14d-6); recordkeeping requirements (§ 17 (a) (1) and Rule 17a-3); and margin requirements (§§ 7(c), 7(f), and Regulations X and T). The Court held that since Bilzerian's September 27, 1989 nine-count criminal conviction was based on the same facts alleged by the Commission in support of these claims, Bilzerian was "collaterally estopped from relitigating the facts underlying his conviction." The Court further found that permanent injunctive relief was appropriate since "there is a reasonable likelihood that Bilzerian will violate these provisions of the federal securities laws in the future."

Bilzerian's violations of the securities laws relate to his acquisitions during 1985-88 of the securities of Cluett Peabody & Co., Hammermill Paper Company, H.H. Robertson Co., Inc. and Armco, Inc. The Court's Order contemplates further proceedings to require Bilzerian to account for and disgorge all profits and monies received and losses avoided as a result of his illegal conduct. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MAS POOLED TRUST FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by MAS Pooled Trust Fund (Fund), Miller Anderson & Sherrerd (Adviser), and all future portfolios of the Fund advised by the Adviser for an order under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act. MERRILL LYNCH KECALP GROWTH INVESTMENTS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP 1983

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Merrill Lynch KECALP Growth Investments Limited Partnership 1983, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1984, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1986, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1987, Merrill Lynch KECALP L.P. 1989 (Partnerships), KECALP Inc., Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc. (ML & Co.), and Merrill Lynch Interfunding Inc. for a conditional order under Sections 6(b) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder that would amend a previous order. The amendment would provide an exemption from Section 17(d) to permit certain joint transactions involving investments in which ML & Co. and/or its affiliates and the Partnerships are participants; and exemption from Section 17(a) to permit certain sales of securities to the Partnerships by ML & Co. and its affiliates. CHARTER NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by Charter National Life Insurance Company (Charter), Charter National Variable Annuity Account (Charter Variable Account), First Charter Life Insurance Company (First Charter), First Charter Variable Annuity Account (First Charter Variable Account), CNL, Inc., and Scudder Fund Distributors, Inc. (Scudder) for an order under Sections 11(a) and 11(c) of the Investment Company Act. The application was made in connection with certain flexible premium variable deferred annuity contracts issued by Charter or First Charter, through the Charter Variable Account or the First Charter Variable Account, or substantially similar contracts which may be issued in the future through additional subaccounts of the Charter Variable Account, or through other separate accounts of Charter or First Charter. PAINEWEBBER AMERICA FUND

The order would permit the Funds (a) to issue three classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, one of which would convert into another class after a specified period permitting investors to benefit from lower Rule 12b-1 distribution fees; and (b) to assess a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of shares of one of the classes. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

IE INDUSTRIES INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 29 to comment on a proposal by IE Industries Inc. (IE Industries), an Iowa public-utility holding company, to acquire directly all of the outstanding common stock of Iowa Southern Inc. (Iowa Southern), an Iowa public-utility holding company, and, through such acquisition, to acquire all of the outstanding common stock of Iowa Southern Utilities Company and Terra Comfort Corporation, both wholly-owned public-utility subsidiaries of Iowa Southern. AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY
