COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC FILES BRIEF

James R. Doty, General Counsel of the Commission, announced on April 12 that the Commission has filed a brief as amicus curiae in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit in Howe v. Goldcorp Investments Ltd., et al. The Commission's brief urges reversal of a district court's decision which dismissed on forum non conveniens grounds a private federal securities law action on behalf of a class of U.S. shareholders against a foreign issuer. The Commission's brief takes the position that the court erred as a matter of law because the special venue provisions of the federal securities laws preclude dismissal on such grounds. In addition, the Commission's brief argues that even if the forum non conveniens doctrine is available in federal securities law actions, class actions asserting federal securities law claims for damages should rarely be dismissed on forum non conveniens grounds. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST BRUCE BLACK

The New York Regional Office announced that on March 8 the Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Bruce Black (Black), formerly associated with Woodmere Securities, Inc. (Woodmere), a broker-dealer registered with the Commission until September 3, 1990, when it terminated its registration. Woodmere was located in Hewlett, New York.

The Order Instituting Proceedings (Order) alleges that Black willfully violated Sections 5(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and that he willfully aided and abetted violations of Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act. The Order contends that from May 1988 through April 1989, Black misappropriated approximately \$2,028,407 from customers who had given him money to invest in various securities; and that from January 1989 through March 1989, Black obtained approximately \$300,000 through the fraudulent sale of unregistered securities. The Order also contends that in or around April 1989, Black aided and abetted violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions by D.L. Cabot, Inc., an entity Black co-founded, which operated as an unregistered broker-dealer.

The Order further alleges that on October 11, 1990, a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Order of Disgorgement, an Accounting, and Post-Judgment Discovery against Black by default was issued by the Honorable Jack B. Weinstein, U.S. District Judge, Eastern District of New York, enjoining him from committing or aiding and abetting violations of Sections 5(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Act and Sections 15(a)(1) and 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

A hearing will be scheduled to determined whether the allegations against Black are true and, if so, to decide what if any remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-29059)

MAST/KEYSTONE CONSENTS TO FINDINGS AND STOP ORDER SUSPENDING REGISTRATION STATEMENT

On April 8, the Commission issued a stop order pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933, suspending the effectiveness of the registration statement filed by Mast/Keystone, Inc. (MKI) on or about September 10, 1990. Without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, MKI consented to the issuance of the stop order.

The Commission found that the registration statement contained audit opinions and letters of consent to the use of the audit opinions, which were included without the prior knowledge or consent of three auditors. The Commission further found that the registration statement failed to disclose the following: a) certain material relationships between MKI directors and between MKI and the two entities on whose behalf the registration statement was filed, The Mills-Jennings Co. and Coin Devices, Inc.; b) the existence of a judgment enjoining an MKI director from violations of federal securities laws; c) the effect registration of the 3,320,000 shares would have on the value of and market for existing shares; and d) MKI's consideration of the possible distribution of MKI shares to shareholders of a related party, The Mills-Jennings Co. (Rel. 33-6890)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-31) to amend Exchange Rules 131 and 154 to allow stop and stop limit orders in certain equity derivative securities to be elected by a quotation (Rel. 34-29063); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-90-56) to amend Article III, Section 26 of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice by adding paragraph (n) that would require members selling investment company shares to disclose the existence of deferred sales charges on the front of the confirmation sent to the customer at the time the shares are purchased by the customer (Rel. 34-29069).

AMENDED APPLICATION FOR FULL CLEARING AGENCY REGISTRATION AND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

The <u>Government Securities Clearing Corporation</u> filed with the Commission an application (File No. 600-23) for registration as a clearing agency or, in the alternative, extension of GSCC's temporary registration as a clearing agency. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 15. (Rel. 34-29067)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Participants Trust Company</u> filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-PTC-91-04) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to continue its Interim Program commenced in February 1991. The Commission approved the proposed rule change on an accelerated basis. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 15. (Rel. 34-29068)
