## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### TRANSAMERICA CASH RESERVE AND TRANSAMERICA CURRENT INTEREST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Transamerica Cash Reserve, Inc. (TCR) and Transamerica Current Interest, Inc. (Current Interest). The application is for an order of the Commission, pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act, granting relief from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit TCR to acquire substantially all of the assets and certain liabilities of one of the Current Interest portfolios known as Transamerica Money Market Fund in exchange for shares of TCR. # ASSOCIATED CAPITAL INSTITUTIONAL TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Associated Capital Institutional Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18127 - May 1)

# FAHNESTOCK & COMPANY

A conditional order has been issued pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Fahnestock & Co. Inc. and Hudson Capital Advisors, Inc. from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act. The exemption relieves applicants from any ineligibility resulting from the employment of an individual who is subject to a securities-related injunction. (Rel. IC-18128 - May 1)

#### FIRST VARIABLE ANNUITY FUND BE OF FIRST VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that First Variable Annuity Fund BE of First Variable Life Insurance Company has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18129 - May 1)

#### CHARTER NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued under Sections 11(a) and 11(c) of the Investment Company Act to Charter National Life Insurance Company (Charter), Charter National Variable Annuity Account (Charter Variable Account), First Charter Life Insurance Company (First Charter), First Charter Variable Annuity Account (First Charter Variable Account), CNL, Inc., and Scudder Fund Distributors, Inc. The order concerns (1) certain flexible premium variable deferred annuity contracts issued by Charter or First Charter through the Charter Variable Account or the First Charter Variable Account; or (2) substantially similar contracts which may be issued in the future through additional subaccounts of the Charter Variable Account or First Charter Variable Account, or through other separate accounts of Charter or First Charter. ## THE BENHAM VARIABLE ACCOUNT OF MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The Benham Variable Account of Monarch Life Insurance Company has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18131 - May 1)

#### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### NEW ENGLAND HYDRO FINANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued concerning New England Hydro Finance Company, Inc. (Hydro-Finance), a subsidiary of both New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company, Inc. (NE-Hydro) and New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation (Hydro-TransCorp). Hydro and Hydro-TransCorp are both subsidiaries of New England Electric System and Northeast Utilities, registered holding companies. The order authorizes Hydro-Finance to borrow an aggregate principal amount of up to \$215 million from several institutional lenders through December 31, 1991, and to lend such funds to NE-Hydro and Hydro-TransCorp, respectively, on the same terms and conditions. All borrowings will be evidenced by the issuance of notes and the aggregate of such borrowings shall not exceed \$215 million. Hydro-Finance has been authorized to sell its notes under an exception from competitive bidding. NE-Hydro and Hydro-TransCorp have been authorized to guarantee severally Hydro-Finance's debt service obligations in proportion to their respective actual borrowing levels from Hydro-Finance. #### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> to amend the NASD's Code of Arbitration Procedure (Code). The amendments have been implemented to improve the efficiency of the NASD's arbitration system and enable the Code to reflect current practices. The proposed rule change amends Part III, Sections 13(a), 39(a) and 41(e) of the Code. Specifically, the amendments eliminate the required customer demand or written consent of the parties before application of simplified procedures. Secondly, the rule change requires party service of amended pleadings. Finally, the rule change requires that the name of counsel and the type of security or product in controversy be made additional items

for inclusion in all arbitration awards. Publication of the order approving the proposed rule change was expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 22. (Rel. 34-29132)

# PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by the following under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: <u>Depository Trust Company</u> (SR-DTC-91-08) relating to a new legal notice system (LENS); and <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-91-13) to amend certain provisions of its Uniform Practice Code. Publication of the proposals was expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 29. (Rels. 34-29133 and 34-29134, respectively)

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-91-07) to permit it to implement a cross-margining program with the Board of Trade Clearing Corporation. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 6. (Rel. 34-29142)

#### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Midwest Clearing Corporation</u> filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-MCC-91-02) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act which has become effective immediately. The rule change amends MCC's fee structure relating to Member-to-Member Securities Loans. Publication of the proposal was expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of April 29. (Rel. 34-29143)

#### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change filed by <u>Depository Trust Company</u> under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act (SR-DTC-90-09). The proposal would enable DTC participants to exercise, through DTC, the option of receiving a dividend, interest or principal payment in foreign currency. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 6. (Rel. 34-29144)

# ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column - 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
