INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

VAN KAMPEN MERRITT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Van Kampen Merritt Trust, et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would grant an exemption from Sections 18(f), 18(g) and 18(i) to permit certain open-end investment companies to sell two classes of securities. The order would also grant an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) and Rule 22c-1 to permit such companies to impose a contingent deferred sales load on certain redemptions of shares and to waive the contingent deferred sales load in certain cases. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EDGEWATER DEVELOPMENT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on an application by Edgewater Development Company, Inc., a holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2. The application is for an order under Section 3(a)(1) granting exemption from all provisions of the Act except Section 9(a)(2). (Rel. 35-25318)

MERCER COMPANIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on an application by Mercer Companies, Inc., a holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2. The application is for an order under Section 3(a)(1) granting exemption from all provisions of the Act except Section 9(a)(2). (Rel. 35-25318)

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by Consolidated Natural Gas Company (CNG), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary, CNG Energy Company (CNG Energy). The proposal calls

for CNG Energy through its Natural Gas Vehicle Division (NGV Division) to buy fr suppliers and resell or lease to customers certain vehicular natural gas conversion equipment, which it will install and/or maintain for customers, and to provide training in the use thereof. NGV Division also proposes to design, construct, own, lease, sell and/or maintain natural gas refueling stations or mobile refueling operations for the refueling of natural gas vehicles and to enter into joint ventures with companies or individuals owning service stations to engage in the described activities. NGV Division will also market or distribute at wholesale and/or retail certain natural gas utilizing equipment. CNG proposes to provide CNG Energy with up to \$5 million in funds by purchasing shares of CNG Energy common stock and/or by making long-term loans to CNG Energy. (Rel. 35-25318)

GPU NUCLEAR CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by GPU Nuclear Corporation (GPU Nuclear), a subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company. GPU Nuclear proposes to grant from time to time through December 31, 2001 to nonassociate companies and to contractors and organizations associated with the nuclear industry non-exclusive, non-transferable licenses to use GPU Nuclear's computerized data system, known as the Nuclear Employee Data System, in return for a monthly licensing fee to be negotiated with the prospective licensees. CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following: Consolidated Natural Gas Company (Consolidated); its wholly owned subsidiaries, CNG Research Company, Consolidated Natural Gas Service Company, Inc., CNG Coal Company, CNG Producing Company (Producing) and its subsidiary, CNG Pipeline Company (Pipeline), and CNG Transmission Corporation; and Consolidated's public-utility subsidiary companies, The Peoples Natural Gas Company, The East Ohio Gas Company, The River Gas Company, Virginia Natural Gas, Inc., Hope Gas, Inc., and West Ohio Gas Company (Subsidiaries). The proposal calls for the following through June 30, 1992: (1) \$600 million in short-term commercial paper financing by Consolidated; (2) the sale of \$450 million in short-term notes to banks by Consolidated; (3) Consolidated to make up to \$986 million in open account advances and/or long-term loans to and/or capital stock purchases from its Subsidiaries; (4) Producing to make up to \$1 million in open account advances and/or long-term loans to or purchases of common stock from Pipeline; (5) increases in any Subsidiary's authorized common stock; (6) a reverse stock split by certain Subsidiaries; and (7) the purchase and retirement of Producing's common stock from Consolidated. THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT & POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Connecticut Light & Power Company and Western Massachusetts Electric Company (Applicants), each a public-utility subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company. Applicants propose to replace an existing credit facility for financing the acquisition of nuclear fuel with a new \$230 million revolving credit facility (Facility) with a syndicate of banks. The First National Bank of Chicago (FNB-Chicago) would serve as agent. The Applicants propose to continue their authorization through December 31, 1998 to (1) make borrowings under

the Facility; (2) issue intermediate-term notes of up to \$300 million; and (3) sell commercial paper notes (Commercial Paper) under an exception from competitive bidding which, together with borrowings under the Facility, would not exceed \$230 million aggregate principal amount outstanding at any one time. Applicants propose to amend certain existing agreements regarding nuclear leasing, security and assignment of contracts. (Rel. 35-25318)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-23) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to provide for appropriate margin deposits for short customer currency options positions in cross-rate currency options. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 27. (Rel. 34-29225)

TEMPORARY APPROVAL OF REGISTRATION

The Commission has approved on a temporary basis the registration as a clearing agency of the Government Securities Clearing Corporation (GSCC). The Commission approved GSCC's registration until May 31, 1993. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 3. (Rel. 34-29236)
