COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC ANNOUNCES DEPARTURE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS DIRECTOR

The Commission announced today that Mary McCue, Director of the Office of Public Affairs, will leave the Commission on September 6, 1991. Later in September, she will join Burson-Marstellar, the international public relations/public affairs firm, in its Washington office, where she will specialize in financial communications.

In commenting on Ms. McCue's departure, Chairman Richard C. Breeden said, "I know that the Commissioners and staff join me in wishing Mary the very best in her new position, and in expressing our appreciation for her dedicated and diligent service during her tenure as Director of the Office of Public Affairs. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT AGAINST FORST-HUNTER INTERNATIONAL TRADE CORPORATION

On August 20, the Commission announced the filing of a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia. The Commission is seeking permanent injunctions against Forst-Hunter International Trade Corporation (Forst-Hunter), Frank Forst (Forst), President and Chairman of the Board of Forst-Hunter, Kenneth Hassebroek (Hassebroek), Forst-Hunter's Controller and D. Elizabeth Wills (Wills), Forst-Hunter's securities counsel. The complaint seeks to permanently enjoin Forst-Hunter from violating Sections 10(b), 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) and 14(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 12b-25, 13a-1, 13a-13 and 14a-9 thereunder. The complaint also seeks to permanently enjoin Forst from violating Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-2 thereunder, and from aiding and abetting violations of Sections 13(a), 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) and 14(a) and Rules 12b-20, 12b-25, 13a-13 and 14a-9 thereunder. Finally, the complaint seeks to permanently enjoin Hassebroek from aiding and abetting violations of Sections 13(a), 13b)(2)(A) and (B) and Rules 12b-20 and 13a-13 thereunder; and Wills from aiding and abetting violations of Section 14(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 14a-9 thereunder. Simultaneous with the filing of the complaint, and without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein, Forst-Hunter, Forst and Wills consented to entry of final judgments of permanent injunction covering all provisions for which the Commission complains. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GENERAL AMERICAN INVESTORS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by General American Investors Company, Inc. (Fund) and its wholly-owned subsidiary, General American Advisers, Inc. (Advisers). Applicants seek a conditional order under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Investment Company Act to exempt certain transactions from Section 17(a) of the Act. Under Section 6(c) and Rule 17d-1, the conditional order would also permit certain joint transactions otherwise prohibited by Section 17(d) and Rule 17d-1 and under Section 6(c) would exempt the Fund from Section 12(d)(3) and certain directors of the Fund from Section 2(a)(19). The order would permit the Fund to transfer its internal advisory business to Advisers, permit Advisers to issue stock options to its management and permit the Fund and Advisers' management to participate in a future offering of Advisers' stock. ROCHESTER GROWTH FUND

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that Rochester Growth Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18278 - August 20)

NAVIGATOR INCOME SHARES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Navigator Income Shares, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18279 - August 20)

TRANSAMERICA BOND FUND

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Transamerica Bond Fund, et al. (Applicants) under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order exempts Applicants from the provisions of Sections 18(f), 18(g) and 18(i) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit Applicants to offer two classes of shares of certain non-money market investment companies and to offer multiple classes of shares of certain money market funds. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing The Columbia Gas System, Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company and a debtor in possession under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, to engage in up to \$75 million of debtor-in-possession financing prior to September 30, 1991. Columbia will use the funds primarily to finance the current operating needs of certain of its subsidiaries. (Rel. 35-25363)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 11 to comment on the application of the <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> for unlisted trading privileges in one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the <u>Philadelphia Stock Exchange</u> to strike from listing and registration Mills-Jennings Company, Common Stock, Par Value \$.02. (Rel. 34-29584)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-24) submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> that amends Appendix F to Article II, Section 34, of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice (Appendix F). The proposed rule change prohibits NASD members from receiving compensation for soliciting votes or tenders from participants in connection with a roll-up of a direct participation program (DPP) and in some cases from participating in the solicitation of votes and tenders unless certain requirements are met. In addition the proposal sets forth a definition of "roll-up" or "roll-up of a DPP." (Rel. 34-29582)
