## AMENDMENTS TO RULE 3a12-8 NOTICED FOR COMMENT

The Commission has noticed for comment a proposal to amend Rule 3a12-8 (17 CFR 240.3a12-8) to designate debt obligations issued by the Republics of Ireland and Italy as "exempted securities" for the purpose of marketing and trading futures contracts on those securities in the United States, and to replace all the references made to the informal names of the countries listed in the Rule with references to their official names. Publication of the notice is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 18. (Rel. 34-29929; International Series Rel. 341; File S7-32-91)

# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT KURTZ, JR. SANCTIONED

The Commission has issued an Order Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions (Order) pursuant to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Robert F. Kurtz, Jr. (Kurtz), formerly employed in the Philadelphia office of Kidder, Peabody & Co., Inc. (Kidder) as a registered representative. The findings and remedial sanctions are in accordance with an Offer of Settlement (Offer) submitted by Kurtz whereby he consented to the Order, without admitting or denying the findings therein.

On the basis of the Order and Kurtz' Offer, the Commission found that during the period from June 1988 through November 1989, Kurtz engaged in a scheme to misappropriate \$1,507,815 from two Kidder customer accounts for which he served as account executive. Kurtz forged signatures on checks drawn on the accounts and deposited the checks directly into his personal bank account or into the accounts of other Kidder customers for which Kurtz served as account executive. The Commission also found that Kurtz engaged in a check-kiting scheme to conceal his misappropriation.

On September 23, 1991, the Commission filed an injunctive action against Kurtz based upon similar allegations (LR-12989).

Based on the above findings and Offer, Kurtz was barred from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company or investment adviser. (Rel. 34-29917)

#### SETTLEMENT OFFER OF JAY COX ACCEPTED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Public Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions against Jay Kenneth Cox and accepting Cox's Offer of Settlement.

From July 1984 to November 1988 Cox was employed as a registered representative at the Kingsport, Tennessee branch office of J.J.B. Hilliard, W.L. Lyons, Inc. Cox admitted to the Commission's findings that he was convicted in Tennessee state court on 31 felony counts, including grand larceny, forgery and uttering a forged instrument. Cox also admitted to the Commission's findings that on September 30 1991, a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered by the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Tennessee enjoining Cox from future violations of the antifraud provision of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and rule thereunder. The Commission's complaint filed on September 30, 1991, alleges that Cox, during the period from in or about October 1987 through November 1988, effected unauthorized margin loans to a customer account, forged customers' signatures to letters instructing that his brokerage firm issue checks to customers, forged customers' endorsements to checks issued by his firm and deposited checks payable to his customers into his own accounts for his own use and benefit. The Order, effective immediately, bars Cox from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-29918)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CBC CORNERSTONE FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by CBC Cornerstone Funds, Furman Selz Incorporated, Texas Commerce Investment Management Company and The Portfolio Group, Inc. The order permits CBC Cornerstone Funds and certain other investment companies for which Furman Selz or its affiliates will in the future act as principal underwriter, adviser or administrator to issue and sell separate classes of securities representing interests in the same investment portfolio. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

## PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Public Service Company of Oklahoma (PSO), an electric utility subsidiary company of Central and Southwest Corporation, Inc., a registered holding company, and PSO's mining subsidiary company, Ash Creek Mining Company (Ash Creek). The proposal seeks to extend PSO's authorization to finance Ash Creek through December 31, 1993 and to increase the maximum principal amount of such financing from \$4 million to \$5 million outstanding at any one time. #### EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, to extend EUA's authorization to make capital contributions to its wholly owned electric utility subsidiary, Newport Electric Corporation, through the period ending December 31, 1993. ## OHIO POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Ohio Power Company (OPCo), a electric-utility subsidiary company of American Electric Power Company, a registered holding company, to provide railcar maintenance services for nonassociated entities through December 31, 1996. #### ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 2 to request a hearing on a proposal by Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned electric utility subsidiary company, Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L). The proposal states that LP&L will issue and sell, and Entergy will acquire, from time to time through December 31, 1993, an aggregate of up to 22,753,200 shares of LP&L common stock for an aggregate cash consideration that will not exceed \$150 million. ## ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> (SR-Amex-91-30) to extend for three months the Amex's pilot program regarding the execution of odd-lot market order. (Rel. 34-29922)

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-91-19) under Rule 19b-4 to adopt a new Rule of Fair Practice, the Corporate Financing Rule, which replaces in its entirety the current NASD Interpretation of the Board of Governors - Review of Corporate Financing. The NASD is also proposing to codify its practices related to procedures governing requests for review of Corporate Financing Department determinations in new Article XII to the NASD Code of Procedure. The new rule will be used by the NASD when it reviews underwriting terms and arrangements of securities offerings in which NASD members participate to determine whether those terms and arrangements are fair and reasonable. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of November 18. (Rel. 34-29928)

# ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1).
