INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EMPIRE FIDELITY INVESTMENTS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Empire Fidelity Investments Life Insurance Company, Empire Fidelity Investments Variable Annuity Account A (Account) and Fidelity Brokerage Services, Inc. from Sections 22(d), 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under certain deferred variable annuity contracts and the waiver of the contingent deferred sales charge under the contracts in certain circumstances. SMITH BARNEY L.P. ESC-1, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(b) of the Investment Company Act exempting certain limited partnerships and their general partners from most provisions of the Act and permitting certain affiliated and joint transactions. FOX FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Fox Fund, Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18415 - November 21)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, to make such capital contributions to EUA Cogenex Corporation (Cogenex), a subsidiary company of EUA, as are necessary to maintain the levels of capitalization of Cognex required by an Equity Maintenance Agreement.
