COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL ACTION AGAINST CURRENT FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC., ET AL.

The Commission filed an action against Current Financial Services, Richard Hope, Otis Hope, Clovis Goff, Jr., Alpha Investment Services, American Equity Funding Corp., Med-Fac Investments, Keith Hammond, Current Financial Services of Mississippi, Douglas Rayburn, Victory Financial Services, Strength Financial Concepts, Charles Worley, Jr., David Benner and Carmen Librandi. The action arises out of an on-going scheme to defraud investors by selling debt approximately \$20 million of securities in violation of the registration and antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws.

The Commission alleged that the defendants promised substantial rates of return with no basis for doing so and made other misrepresentations relating to the risks of the investment.

On December 5, Judge Harris of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered an order temporarily restraining the defendants from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions, preventing or limiting transfers or dissipation of assets, appointing a Monitoring Agent to oversee disbursements by one defendant and ordering the defendants to provide accountings. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

UNITED FINANCIAL GROUP, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by United Financial Group, Inc. The application is for an order of the Commission pursuant to Sections 6(c) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicant from all provisions of the Act, subject to certain exceptions, until December 30, 1992. The requested exemption would continue an exemption originally granted until December 30, 1990 and extended by an amended order until December 30, 1991. (Rel. IC-18430 - December 5)

FIRST UNUM LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 30 to request a hearing on an application by First UNUM Life Insurance Company, VA-1 Separate Account of First UNUM Life Insurance Company (Account) and UNUM Sales Corporation. The application is for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-91-63), which was granted accelerated approval to extend until May 5, 1992, operation of the quotation linkage between the NASD and the London Stock Exchange. No substantive changes are approved for the implementation during the extension. However, the additional time is intended to enable the sponsoring markets to consider various options and determine the future course of the experimental project. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 9. (Rel. 34-30033)

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Pursuant to Rule 19b-4, the <u>American Stock Exchange</u> filed Amendment No. 1 to a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-91-20) in order to delete language with respect to the Exchange's proposal to list and trade warrants based on a basket of ten foreign currencies, which would have permitted settlement by means of physical delivery of the underlying currencies, at the election on the holder. Publication of the notice is expected to appear in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 9. (Rel. 34-30037; International Series Rel. 351)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Options Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-OCC-91-19) that would revise the processing sequence of exercises or sales of pledged positions among multiple pledgees. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 9. (Rel. 34-30038)

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes (SR-OCC-90-04 and SR-ICC 90-03) filed by the <u>Options Clearing Corporation</u> and the <u>Intermarket Clearing Corporation</u>. The rule changes amend the rules of OCC and ICC and their intermarket cross-margining agreement to authorize an OCC/ICC Non-Proprietary Cross-Margin Program for positions in market professional accounts carried by participating clearing members.
