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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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PROCEEDINGS AGAINST ERNEST GARCIA, II

The Commission announced that on December 12 it instituted administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Ernest C. Garcia, II. The proceedings are based on the entry, upon Garcia's consent, of a permanent injunction against him prohibiting future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Sections 10(b) and 13(a) of the Exchange Act, and Rules 10b-5, 13a-1, 13a-13 and 13b2-2 thereunder. The injunctive action was based upon Garcia's conduct in connection with American Continental Corporation and its former subsidiary, Lincoln Savings and Loan Association. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, the Commission accepted Garcia's Offer of Settlement in which he consented to the entry of an Order barring him from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. Garcia has a right to reapply the later of three years after the date of the Order or after the termination of any criminal sanctions imposed upon him in connection with a guilty plea entered in U.S. District Court for the Central District of California in a related matter. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the <u>National Association of Securities Dealers</u> (SR-NASD-91-56). The proposal amends Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to require companies which apply for listing on the NASDAQ Stock Market to pay all entry fees at the time application is made for inclusion in the system. The NASD currently collects fees from applicants in two steps: (1) a non-refundable application processing fee; and (2) the entry fee, which is collected on or after the company's entry onto NASDAQ. The rule change joins these two fees at the time application is made to the NASD. (Rel. 34-30084)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-91-21) filed by <u>The Depository Trust Company</u> to allow DTC participants to cancel pending deliver orders in the Next-Day Funds and Same-Day Funds Settlement systems. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of December 23. (Rel. 34-30085)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-90-40) under Rule 19b-4 to amend NYSE Rules 116.40, 123A.43 and 13 in order to modify NYSE procedures for handling and executing market-on-close (MOC) orders on expiration Fridays. The proposal would allow for partial executions of MOC orders, with Floor Governor approval, when significant imbalances occur. Publication of the proposal is expected. The Federal Register during the week of December 23. (Rel. 34-30086)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> (SR-PSE-91-48) to amend its Rule 3.2 in order to provide listing guidelines for hybrid securities products. (Rel. 34-30087)
