OPEN MEETING - FRIDAY, JANUARY 3, 1992 - 10:00 A.M.

The subject of the January 3 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to adopt revisions to the shareholder communications and 1. related rules to implement provisions of the Shareholder Communications Improvement Act of 1990. These amendments would require investment companies registered under the Investment Company Act to distribute information statements to shareholders in connection with a shareholder meeting where proxies, consents or authorizations are not solicited by or on behalf of the registrant. The amendments would also require brokers and banks that hold shares for beneficial owners of securities in nominee name to forward to the beneficial owners the proxy statements of investment companies registered under the Investment Company Act (Investment Company Act registrants). Brokers and banks would also be required to forward information statements of both Investment Company Act registrants and companies with a class of securities registered under Section 12 of the Securities Exchange Act. The amendments, if adopted, will be effective with respect to shareholder meetings held, or authorization, on or after March 31, 1992. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION CONTACT: Elizabeth M. - 2. Consideration of whether to adopt proposed Rule 17Ad-15 under the Securities Exchange Act and an accompanying release that would provide for acceptance of signatures for eligible guarantor institutions of an equitable basis. Rule 17Ad-15 would prohibit inequitable treatment of eligible guarantor institutions and require transfer agents to establish written standards for the acceptance of signature guarantees. Also, Rule 17Ad-15 would enable transfer agents to reject a request for transfer because the guarantor is neither a member of nor a participant in a signature guarantee program. - 3. Consideration of whether to issue for comment proposed Rule 17Ad-16 under the Securities Exchange Act. The rule would require a registered transfer agent to provide written notice to at least one registered securities depository when terminating or assuming transfer agent services on behalf of an issuer of when changing its name or address. COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

HOWARD MORIN APPOINTED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF CORPORATION FINANCE

Chairman Breeden has announced the appointment of Howard F. Morin as Associate Director (Operations) in the Division of Corporation Finance. Mr. Morin will be responsible for the Division's examination program and, under the direction of the Senior Associate Director, will supervise six Assistant Director units, the Office of Engineers, the Office of the Chief Financial Analyst, and coordinate the Division's participation in the development of the Electronic Data Gathering and Retrieval System (EDGAR). Mr. Morin succeeds Ernestine Zipoy who retired earlier in 1991. (Press Rel. 91-71)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

NASD ACTION AGAINST GILBERT ZWETSCH AND TERRY EVANS AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed NASD disciplinary action in two proceedings. In the first proceeding, the NASD censured Gilbert A. Zwetsch of Spokane, Washington and Terry S Evans of Liberty Lake, Washington former registered representatives of Dillon Securities, Inc., an NASD member firm, fined each of them \$15,000, suspended each for 60 days, and ordered Zwetsch to disgorge \$7,480 and Evans \$2,790. In the second proceeding, the NASD censured Zwetsch and fined him \$1,500.

The Commission affirmed NASD findings in the first proceeding that respondents engaged in private securities transactions without giving Dillon proper notification and failed to make material disclosures to customers. In the second proceeding, it affirmed NASD findings that Zwetsch made unsuitable recommendations to customers. (Rel. 34-30092)

WILLIAM KICKLIGHTER, JR., ROBERT BROWN AND TERRY EURICH SANCTIONED

The Commission, increasing sanctions imposed by an administrative law judge, has barred William L. Kicklighter, Jr. of Marietta, Georgia from association with any broker or dealer with the proviso that, after one year and upon a satisfactory showing of adequate supervision, he may apply to become so associated in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity. In addition, the Commission suspended Robert Q. Brown of Dunwoody, Georgia and Terry G. Eurich of Kennesaw, Georgia from association with any broker or dealer for a period of six months, effective December 30. Kicklighter, Brown and Eurich were salesmen in the Atlanta office of the former brokerage firm of Hereth, Orr & Jones, Inc.

The Commission found that, from May to November 1983, Kicklighter made material misstatements to customers in connection with the sale of certain Polk County, Florida bonds and that all of the respondents concealed material information from customers in connection therewith. In imposing a bar on Kicklighter, the Commission stated that there was no justification for his blatant misrepresentations. The Commission further noted that, while their misconduct was not as serious, Brown and Eurich concealed highly material negative information from customers although they were aware of its importance. NASD ACTION AGAINST MATANKY SECURITIES CORP. AND BARRY KREISLER AFFIRMED

The Commission has affirmed NASD disciplinary action against Matanky Securities Corp., a former Chicago broker-dealer, and its president, Barry B. Kreisler. The NASD censured the firm and Kreisler and fined them \$10,000, jointly and severally.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that the firm and Kreisler failed to maintain properly and return payments received in connection with three "all or none" underwritings, failed to comply with a voluntary operating agreement with the NASD and violated net capital requirements. In affirming the NASD's assessment of sanctions, the Commission noted that "the rules that applicants violated are neither technical nor trivial but represent important safeguards imposed for the protection of public investors." BASKIN PLANNING CONSULTANTS, LTD. AND RITA BASKIN ENJOINED

On December 19, the Commission announced the issuance of an Order finding that on November 13 the Honorable Leonard D. Wexler, U.S. District Court Judge for the Eastern District of New York, permanently enjoined Baskin Planning Consultants, Ltd. (Baskin Planning) and Rita Baskin from further violating the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws. The Commission's complaint upon which the injunction was based alleged that between 1983 and 1985 Baskin Planning and Rita Baskin sold unregistered securities issued by Broadhollow Funding Corporation (Broadhollow). Broadhollow held itself out as a real estate mortgage broker, but actually operated a Ponzi scheme. The complaint further alleged that representatives of Baskin Planning, including Rita Baskin failed to adequately investigate Broadhollow before selling its securities to clients; made materially false and misleading statements concerning Broadhollow; failed to disclose the receipt of commissions from Broadhollow; and failed to disclose a \$50,000 unsecured loan to Rita Baskin from Broadhollow.

Based upon the aforementioned injunction, the Commission barred Rita Baskin from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer and revoked Baskin Planning's registration as an investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1297)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

DR FUNDS INC.

An order has been issued under Section \$(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that DR Funds Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18455 - December 24)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered electric utility holding company. CSW requests an extension of previously granted authority, through December 31, 1992, regarding the financings relating to a leveraged employee stock ownership plan (LESOP), including the purchase of up to \$500 million aggregate principal amount of CSW common stock. The common stock would be placed in a LESOP, which is part of CSW's Employees' Thrift Plan. (Rel. 35-25442)

CSW CREDIT, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by CSW Credit, Inc. (Credit), a nonutility subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered electric utility holding company. Credit is authorized to extend its existing authority through December 31, 1992 to borrow up to \$624 million to finance the factoring of receivables. Credit also is authorized to borrow, through December 31, 1992, up to an additional \$200 million to finance the factoring of affiliate receivables. (Rel. 35-25443)

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued concerning National Fuel Gas Company (NFG), a registered gas public-utility holding company. The order authorizes NFG to acquire all of the authorized shares of common stock of National Fuel Resources, Inc. (Resources), a newly-created New York corporation, for \$3.5 million in cash. NFG is also authorized to acquire, through Resources, a 50% interest in a general Partnership (Partnership) with Citizens Gas Supply Corporation for \$1.5 million in cash. Additionally, NFG is authorized to include Resources in the National Fuel System Money Pool for a maximum of \$10 million. Finally, NFG is authorized to make available to the Partnership, through Resources, through December 31, 1991, one or more loans aggregating up to \$10 million. Resources will be engaged in the business of marketing natural gas and related activities and the Partnership will be engaged in purchasing, storing, transporting and marketing natural gas and the acquisition of related assets.
