PROCEDURES FOR EARLY STAFF REVIEW OF EXECUTIVE COMPENSATION DISCLOSURE

In order to facilitate staff review of executive compensation disclosure during the 1994 proxy season, the Commission recently announced in its publication of refinements to the executive compensation requirements [See Rel. No. 33-7032 (November 22, 1993)] that issuers may submit their executive compensation disclosures for staff review prior to filing with the Commission. These submissions should be directed to the attention of John Bernas of the Division of Corporation Finance by mail at Securities Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549, Mail Stop 3-7 or by facsimile to (202) 272-7546. In order to review the draft, the staff would have to be provided with all of the disclosure required by Items 402 and 404 of Regulation S-K and Item 10 of Schedule 14A at least 20 days before comments are necessary. Issuers should confirm receipt of the materials by calling (202) 272-3097. Issuers submitting the information on EDGAR should use the document tag <CORRESP> which will ensure that the information remains non-public. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DECISION SUSPENDING RAY KOBAYASHI FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge suspending Ray H. Kobayashi, a former securities salesman, from association with a broker-dealer for six months has become final. The suspension is effective February 28, 1994. The law judge's action was based on a court order enjoining Kobayashi from violating the registration provisions of the Securities Act and the court's findings that he violated those provisions in connection with the offer and sale of a block of unregistered American Aircraft Corporation stock. Kobayashi had been given that stock by an individual who had obtained it from the issuer as a result of a merger. Kobayashi failed to show that an exemption from registration was available. The law judge found that, despite Kobayashi's knowledge that there were serious questions regarding the free tradeability of the stock, he simply accepted the representations of his donor that there were no restrictions on its sale. NASD ACTION AGAINST JEFFREY HEET MODIFIED

The Commission has modified NASD disciplinary action against Jeffrey J. Heet of Columbia, Illinois. Heet was formerly financial and operations principal of First Gateway Securities Inc., an NASD member firm. The Commission set aside some of the sanctions assessed against Heet -- a fine of \$2,222 and the issuance of a letter of caution --, but affirmed the remaining sanctions imposed by the NASD -- censure, a \$2,500 joint and several fine, and the requirement that Heet requalify as a financial and operations principal.

The Commission set aside the NASD's findings that Heet was responsible for unfair markups and commissions charged by his firm in 1990, noting that the responsibility rested with other firm officials. However, the Commission affirmed the NASD's findings that Heet was responsible for 1990 recordkeeping violations by the firm. It accordingly set aside the sanctions assessed against Heet for the unfair markups and commissions, and sustained those assessed for the recordkeeping infractions. (Rel. 34-33625)

FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST DANIEL TEYIBO, a/k/a DANIEL TEYIDO AND JFM GOVERNMENT SECURITIES, INC.

The Commission announced that on February 2 the Honorable Benson Everett Legg, United States District Judge in the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against defendants Daniel O. Teyibo, a/k/a Daniel O. Teyido (Teyibo), and JFM Government Securities, Inc. (JFM Government). The Order enjoins Teyibo and JFM Government from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and the registration provision for dealers of government securities under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The injunction was issued in connection with a wide-spread fraudulent "free riding" scheme in which the defendants solicited and engaged in transactions involving almost \$1 billion of U.S. Treasury securities. The Court found that the defendants had failed to comply with the Court's orders; provide the Commission with discovery; and otherwise defend the action. Accordingly, the Court granted the Commission a judgment by default and ordered defendants to disgorge \$823,275.81, representing defendants' trading profits and money losses avoided. Additionally, the Court imposed a civil money penalty of \$100,000 against defendants, which represents, in part, the Commission's costs in investigating and prosecuting the action. [SEC v. Daniel O. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLLEGE PREPAYMENT FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by College Prepayment Fund, Inc. for an order pursuant to Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. THE PNC FUND, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by The PNC Fund, et al. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from the provisions of Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act. The requested relief would permit the existing and future investment portfolios of The PNC Fund to create up to three classes of shares. (Rel. IC-20081 - February 17)

RYDEX SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 14 to request a hearing on an application filed by Rydex Series Trust, et al. for a conditional order pursuant to Sections 6(c) and 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder to permit the operation of a joint trading account in repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-20082 - February 17)

An order has been issued granting the application of the Chicago Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in 5 over-the-counter issues and an application to withdraw unlisted trading privileges in 5 over-the-counter issues. (Rel. 34-33624)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 9 to comment on the application of Commercial Net Lease Realty, Inc. to withdraw its Common Stock, \$0.01 Par Value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-33628)

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Boston Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Summa RX Laboratories, Inc., Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value. (Rel. 34-33629)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR NASD-93-76) to allow the NASD's National Business Conduct Committee to designate a Subcommittee to approve or reject Acceptance, Waiver and Consents, Minor Rule Violation Letters, and Offers of Settlement. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 21. (Rel. 34-33627)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-07) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange and granted accelerated approval to Amendment No. 2 of the proposed rule change relating to an increase in position and exercise limits for options on the National Over-the-Counter Index. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 21. (Rel. 34-33634)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-94-04) to amend its rules to codify its existing policy on customer hedge exemption procedures for options on broad-based indexes has become effective upon filing with the Commission. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of February 21. (Rel. 34-33638)

TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted temporary accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-93-04) to implement, on a pilot basis until October 31, 1994, certain procedures for the handling of market-on-close orders on Expiration Fridays and Quarterly Index Expiration days. (Rel. 34-33639)
