COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT TO TESTIFY

Chairman Levitt will testify on Thursday, May 12, 1994, before the Subcommittee on Securities of the Senate Banking Committee. The testimony concerns the Central Bank of Denver case and is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. in Room 538 of the Dirksen Senate Office Building.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF UDC HOMES, INC. AND REX MANZ

The Commission today issued an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Making Findings, and Cease and Desist Order against UDC Homes, Inc. (UDC) and Rex H. Manz, UDC's chief accounting officer during the relevant time period. The Commission accepted Offers of Settlement from UDC and Manz pursuant to which, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings, the respondents consented to the entry of the Order, which requires that UDC permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation, and any future violation, of Section 13(a) and the rules thereunder, and



Sections 13(b)(2)(A) & (B) of the Exchange Act, and that Manz permanently cease and desist from causing any violation, or any future violation, of the same provisions. The Commission found that UDC materially misstated its net income reported in its quarterly report on Form 10-Q for the period ended September 31, 1991. For the nine-month period then ended, UDC reported net income of \$3,192,000 when it should have reported a loss of \$13,145,000, and reported net income of \$2,335,000 for the three month period ended September 31, 1991, when it should have reported a loss of \$14,002,000. The misstatement resulted from UDC's failure to write down its real estate holdings to net realizable value and to adjust the absorption rate for its indirect costs overhead pool on a timely basis, as required under Generally Accepted Accounting Principles. INDICTMENT RELEASED ALLEGING FRAUDULENT PRIME BANK OFFERING

The Commission announced that on February 18, 1994, David D. Freudenthal, United States Attorney for the District of Wyoming released an indictment which was returned against Stephen T. Cross, Stewart W. Cross, James G. Hands III and Delton Olson. The indictment charges the defendants with conspiracy to launder money, mail fraud, and wire fraud in a scheme involving the offer and sale of investments in a "prime bank letter of credit program." On November 22, 1993, the Commission announced the filing of its complaint against Northstar Investors Trust, SLM Corp., Cross & Associates, Stephen Cross, Stewart Cross, James G. Hands III and Delton Olson alleging violations of the securities antifraud provisions related to the same investment program. [U.S. v. Stephen T. Cross, Stewart W. THOMAS QUINN MUST PAY \$26 MILLION

The Commission announced that on May 2 the Honorable Milton Shadur, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Illinois, entered an Order of Disgorgement (Order) against Thomas Quinn (Quinn). The Order requires Quinn to disgorge \$25,990,763.98, inclusive of prejudgment interest of \$13,595,605.01, within 90 days of the date of the Order. Judge Shadur ordered Quinn to make the disgorgement in order to strip Quinn of the ill-gotten gains that Quinn received from his participation in a massive fraud in the sale of the securities, of GSS Venture Capital Corporation (GSS) and Max, Inc. (Max). Quinn has previously been permanently enjoined as a result of his participation in the scheme involving GSS and Max. The Court also ordered that approximately \$500,000 held in a money market account under a Quinn alias be turned over to the Receiver appointed in this case.

CRIMINAL ACTION AGAINST JOHN FAULS III AND ROBERT BURSTEIN

The Commission and the United States Attorney for the Northern District of Illinois announced that on May 3 John L. Fauls III was found guilty of securities fraud, mail fraud, bribing a pension fund official, and racketeering following a two week jury trial. Fauls, a former stockbroker, and Robert Burstein, a pension fund manager and a director of a bank, engaged in a scheme to rig securities transactions, executed through Fauls, to insure a profit to the bank of which Burstein was a director, at the expense of the pension fund. Burstein had previously entered a guilty plea. The scheme involved interpositioning the bank between the fund and the market and also allocating profitable trades to the bank instead of the pension fund. The pension fund was defrauded out of a total of approximately \$3,500,000. Fauls also bribed Burstein to direct securities trades through Fauls to enable Fauls to earn compensation for executing those transactions. Fauls received payments for his brokerage firm totaling approximately \$2,500,000 for executing transactions for the pension fund. The Midwest Regional Office of the Securities and Exchange Commission participated in the criminal investigation. [U.S. v. John L. Fauls III and Robert Burstein, Criminal No. 93 CR 80, N.D. HOLDING COMPANY

GULF POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Gulf Power Company, an electric public utility subsidiary company of The Southern Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$150 million of term-loan notes prior to January 1, 1997 and/or \$100 million of unsecured short-term and/or commercial paper notes through March 31, 1995 such that the aggregate principal amount at any one time outstanding does not exceed \$150,000,000. (Rel. 35-26049)

PENN FUEL GAS, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued granting an application by Penn Fuel Gas, Inc. (PFG), a Pennsylvania holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act pursuant to Rule 2, and Carol Ware Gates, Marilyn Ware Lewis, John H. Ware IV and Paul W. Ware. Applicants have

received authorization under Sections 9(a)(2) and 10 for acquisitions of common shares of PFG, and related transactions, pursuant to certain trust and voting agreements. Applicants' request for an order under Section 3(a)(1) exempting PFG from all provisions of the Act, except Section 9(a)(2), has also been granted. (Rel. 35-26050)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Pacific Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-94-3) amending its net capital rules for specialists. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of May 16. (Rel. 34-34026)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-94-4) filed by the <u>Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board</u> to provide procedures for submitting information on political contributions pursuant to Rule G-37. The Commission granted accelerated approval of the proposed rule change to allow for the timely submission of, and public access to, information concerning political contributions. The Commission also published notice to solicit comments on the proposed rule change from interested persons. Publication of the order in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of May 16. (Rel. 34-34027)
