ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

FINDINGS MADE AND SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST FORMER AFFILIATES OF F.D. ROBERTS, SECURITIES, INC.

The Commission made findings and imposed remedial sanctions against Frederick Galiardo, John Perfetti, Morton Greenberg, Albert Weiss, Pamella Rutherford, Ronald Bruce Lieberman, Michael Recchia, John Conte, Kevin Zacharewicz, Robert Eli Gregg, and Joseph Muscolina (Respondents)

in connection with the recently instituted administrative proceedings against the Respondents and others. The Respondents were former officers, directors, managers and/or registered representatives of F.D. Roberts Securities, Inc. (F.D. Roberts), a registered broker-dealer which ceased operations in February 1989. The Respondents submitted, and the Commission accepted, Offers of Settlement whereby each of the Respondents consented to a finding that each Respondent had individually pled guilty in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey to a criminal Indictment or Information based on his or her participation in a massive stock manipulation scheme while affiliated with F.D. Roberts and a permanent bar from the securities industry. (Rel. 34-34447)

JOHN MORGAN AND GREGORY SCOTT PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Commission announced that on July 27 it ordered John L. Morgan (Morgan) and Gregory L. Scott (Scott) permanently barred from association with any broker or dealer. Morgan and Scott did not answer the Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings issued on April 11 (the Order). It was found, based upon the Order, that Morgan and Scott had operated an unregistered broker-dealer from at least April 1989 until April 1991, and failed to cause the broker-dealer to comply with various broker-dealer provisions. In addition, the Order finds that Morgan and Scott made material misrepresentations about the use of customer funds and omitted to inform investors that their funds would be used to pay the broker-dealer's expenses and the personal expenses of Morgan and Scott. Finally, the Order found that an order of permanent injunction had been entered against Morgan and Scott on December 15, 1993, by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio. SEC RESTRICTS RETAIL ACTIVITIES OF HIBBARD, BROWN & COMPANY, INC., RICHARD BROWN, AND ANTHONY NADINO PENDING REVIEW OF NASD ACTION

On August 2, the Commission issued a stay order that prohibits the retail securities activities of Hibbard, Brown & Company, Inc., Richard P. Brown, the firm's president, and Anthony Nadino, its head trader. The Commission's order prevents the firm and the two principals from trading for current or new customers and from underwriting offerings to retail customers.

The order was issued in connection with a recent NASD disciplinary action expelling the firm and barring Brown and Nadino. The NASD found that the firm, Brown, and Nadino charged retail customers excessive markups in sales of Site-Based Media, Inc. common stock. The firm and the two principals appealed the NASD's decision to the Commission, and requested a stay of the NASD's sanctions pending the Commission's review

of the case. While noting that the NASD's findings are grave, the Commission's order also observes that the firm and its principals have raised substantial challenges to the NASD's decision. In light of the issues raised, the Commission issued a partial stay of the NASD's sanctions, but imposed a number of restrictions that protect public customers by prohibiting the firm's participation in retail securities transactions. MICHELLE GERSTNER FOUND IN CONTEMPT OF COURT

The Commission announced that on July 29 the United States District Court for the District of Columbia found Michelle A. Gerstner to be in contempt of court for her refusal to comply with a prior order of the On June 10, 1994, the Court had entered an Order compelling Gerstner, the former manager of Parkersburg Wireless LLC (PWLLC), to "immediately and fully identify" to the Commission the custodians of \$260,000 in PWLLC investor funds that Gerstner had transferred. Gerstner refused to comply with the June 10 Order, asserting the Fifth Amendment privilege against self-incrimination. The Court found in the July 29 Order that Gerstner had waived the privilege because, in a sworn deposition taken earlier in the litigation, she had given the names of the entity and individual who had received the transferred monies. The Court ordered Gerstner to purge the contempt by August 15, 1994, and directed that, beginning on August 16, \$100 per day will be deducted from the \$2,000 that Gerstner is permitted to use each month for personal living expenses, under the terms of an asset freeze that was imposed by the Court in this matter. The Order further provides that, if Gerstner has not purged the contempt by August 31, the Court will consider whether Gerstner should be incarcerated for such time as she remains in contempt. ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST MICHAEL POMPEY AND AMERICANA FINANCIAL GROUP, INC.

On August 3, the Commission filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York against Americana Financial Group, Inc. and Michael W. Pompey, its sole owner and president. The complaint alleges that Pompey and Americana violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint seeks a permanent injunction against future violations by Pompey and Americana of those provisions of the federal securities laws and civil penalties. Pompey's alleged wrongful conduct stemmed from his offer for sale of a fake Series 57M, fifty billion yen Japanese government bond (the equivalent at the time of approximately \$419 million) to several securities brokerage firms in New York and Japan. CHARLES BAZARIAN SENTENCED TO FIFTEEN YEARS

The Commission and Vicki Miles-LaGrange, United States Attorney for the Western District of Oklahoma, announced that on July 7, a federal judge sentenced Charles J. Bazarian of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, to 15 years in prison. Bazarian was indicted on January 11, 1994 on thirty-nine counts, twenty-three of which alleged violations of the federal securities laws. Bazarian pleaded guilty on March 4, 1994 to one count each of securities fraud, wire fraud, making false statements to the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp., money laundering and escape. The securities and wire fraud counts are related to Bazarian's conduct with Remington Financial Group, Inc., a publicly-traded company. [SEC v. Charles Joseph Bazarian, W.D. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

TREASURY FIRST INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Treasury First Inc. for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-20436 - August 2)

AMERICAN UNITED LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by American United Life Insurance Company (AUL), AUL American Individual Unit Trust (Variable Account), and any other investment accounts (Other Accounts) established by AUL in the future to support certain individual variable annuity contracts (collectively, Applicants). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit payment to AUL from the Variable Account or Other Accounts of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance and sale of certain individual variable annuity contracts as well as other substantially similar variable annuity contracts that may in the future be issued by other AUL separate accounts. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company (collectively, Utilities), electric public utility subsidiaries of General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company, and GPU Service Corporation (Service Company), a service company subsidiary of GPU. The Utilities propose to lease, from time to time through December 31, 2002, to non-affiliated companies (Lessees) up to 50% of the fiber line miles of a fiber optic communications system (Fiber Optic System), comprised of a cable containing an overhead ground wire and 36 optical fibers. The Fiber Optic System is owned by the Utilities and operated and maintained by the Service Company. The Service Company proposes to perform Fiber Optic System-related maintenance and equipment services for the Lessees. (Rel. 35-26095)
