INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF VIRGINIA

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; OHIO POWER COMPANY

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NYSE-87-47) would increase the NYSE's floor facilities fees. (Rel 34-25429)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP HOMEOWNERS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 4 to request a hearing on an application by Citicorp Homeowners, Inc. and Citicorp under Section 310(b)(1) (ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Mercantile Bank N.A. under an indenture and certain Pooling and Servicing Agreements is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under the indenture and the Agreements. The indenture is dated September 1, 1984 and the securities outstanding under it are \$400 million of collateralized mortgage obligations, issued in series, evidencing interests in mortgage loans. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
