ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF FEES

The General Counsel sent a letter to Frederick K. DeKuyper denying his application for waiver of fees in connection with his request under the Freedom of Information Act for information relating to College Retirement Equities Fund. The General Counsel determined that the request did not meet the requirements for fee waiver, as set forth in 5 USC 552(a)(4)(A)(iii) and the Commission's Rule 80(e)(4), 17 CFR 200.80(e)(4). (Rel. METROPOLITAN LIFE VARIABLE ACCOUNT C; METROPOLITAN VARIABLE ACCOUNT B OF METROPOLITAN LIFE; METROPOLITAN VARIABLE ACCOUNT D OF METROPOLITAN LIFE

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 15 to request a hearing on an application filed by Metropolitan Life Variable Account C of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company; Metropolitan Variable Account B of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company; and Metropolitan Variable Account D of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company seeking an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. COLONIAL VALUE INVESTING PORTFOLIOS-INCOME PORTFOLIO

An order has been issued on an application filed by Colonial Value Investing Portfolios-Income Portfolio (Income Trust), Colonial Value Investing Portfolios-Equity Portfolio (Equity Trust), and Colonial Investment Services, Inc., its principal underwriter, permitting the Income Trust to issue two classes of shares and permitting the Income Trust and the Equity Trust to assess a contingent deferred sales charge and waive those charges in certain circumstances. TCI PORTFOLIOS INCORPORATED

An order has been issued exempting TCI Portfolios Inc. and Investors Research Corporation from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit shares of the Fund to be sold to separate accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies in conjunction with variable annuity contracts and variable life insurance contracts. EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes filed by the following have become effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934: The Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-88-1) to amend its Listing Fee Schedule to provide a \$5,000 listing fee credit to companies who list stock purchase rights on the Exchange effective January 1, 1988. (Rel. 34-25480); and The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-88-1) to amend Board rules on the payment of per diems to Board members attending designated Board activities and on the election of the Board officers. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NYSE-87-45) requesting permanent approval of its policy for reviewing combination among specialists units. The NYSE also proposes to amend the sixth guideline employed in a Tier I review. The Commission granted accelerated approval to that portion of the policy until such time as it makes a final determination on whether to approve or disapprove the policy on a permanent basis.
