CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

RECEIVER APPOINTED OVER THE ASSETS OF PHILLIP A. JUSTICE, OTHERS

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on April 13 and 20 U.S. District Court Judge Alice Batchelder, Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, entered Orders appointing Richard A. Baumgart, of the law firm of Dettelbach & Sichernan Co., L.P.A., as Receiver over the assets of Phillip A. Justice (Justice), Professional Insurance Services, Inc., The Center for Financial & Tax Planning, Inc., Professional Services, and Justice & Associates. The Court also ordered that the Receiver evaluate the financial condition of the defendants and, based upon such evaluation, develop and present to the Court a plan of payment of \$200,000 to the Clerk of the District Court. The Court had previously found, on March 16, that Justice was in civil contempt of an Order issued on December 14, 1987 which required Justice to make payments totaling \$200,000. (SEC v. Phillip A. Justice, et al., NDOH, Civil Action No. C 87 3199, filed December 4, 1987). (LR-11730)

HARVEY GOLDSMITH ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on April 29 Judge James McGirr Kelly, U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction enjoining Harvey Goldsmith from future violations of the reporting and Foreign Corrupt Practices Act provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Goldsmith consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations. On the same date, the Commission stipulated to a dismissal, without prejudice, of its allegations that Goldsmith violated the antifraud provisions.

The Commission, in its November 13, 1986 Complaint, alleged that Goldsmith, through Hart Systems, Inc. and WTFC, Ltd., two companies he controlled, had aided and abetted a false billing scheme directed by Robert DeBiasse, then president of Computer Input Services, Inc. (CISI). As a result of the scheme, CISI overstated revenue and income in filings with the Commission in the amount of \$240,508, and assets by \$183,800. The Commission alleged that Goldsmith accepted inflated or fictitious invoices from CISI, falsely billed CISI for services never performed, and sent two false audit confirmation letters to CISI's independent auditors. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

An order has been issued exempting The Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York (MONY) and MONY Variable Account-C from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the Accounts in connection with the issuance of certain individual flexible premium variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-16397 - May 10)

AMERICAN CAPITAL CALIFORNIA TAX-EXEMPT TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Capital California Tax-Exempt Trust and other investment companies which are part of the American Capital Mutual Fund Group (Funds) for an order exempting the Funds from the provisions of Section 32(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act to permit them to file financial statements signed or certified by an independent public accountant selected at a board of directors' or trustees' meeting held within 90 days before or after the beginning of the Funds' fiscal years. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES

A Memorandum Opinion and Order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, EUA Power Corporation, through May 14, 1989 for EUA Power (1) under an exception from competitive bidding to (a) exchange up to \$180 million of 17-1/2% Series A Secured Notes for up to \$180 million of 17-1/2% Series B Securities Notes and up to 180,000 Contingent Interest Certificates, (b) issue 17-1/2% Series C Notes to Series B and Series C Noteholders in lieu of cash interest payments on the Series B and Series C Notes for May 15, 1988 and November 15, 1988; and (c) issue and sell up to \$16.5 million of Class A Cumulative Convertible Preferred Stock to EUA; and (2) to amend its Certificate of Incorporation to increase its capital stock by 250,000 shares of Preferred Stock. EUA has been authorized through May 14, 1989 to acquire up to \$16.5 million of Preferred Stock and to issue up to \$16.5 million of short-term notes under its bank lines of credit. Jurisdiction has been reserved after May 14, 1989 over certain matters. The Attorney General for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts's request for a hearing has been denied. (Rel. 35-24641 - May 12)

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange: (SR-Phlx-88-13) to permit the orderly introduction of quarter point strike price intervals for French franc options contracts. (Rel. 34-25685); and The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-14) to decrease the minimum fractional change for dealing on the Exchange in British pound options contracts from \$.0005 to \$.0001. (Rel. 34-25686)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change has been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-88-18) to modify the hours business trading may be conducted in foreign currency options. (Rel. 34-25687); and The Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-88-6) requesting permanent approval of its Same-Day Funds Settlement Service. (Rel. 34-25691)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 16.

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-11) to implement the Order Confirmation Transaction Service and modify the system's operational procedures. (Rel. 34-25690)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

ALLIED-SIGNAL INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Allied-Signal Inc. that the trusteeship of The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association) under two indentures and a Note Facility Agreement of Allied-Signal is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under the indentures and the Note Facility Agreement.
