CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST JOHN L. VAN HORN

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on October 25 the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California entered an Order permanently enjoining John L. Van Horn from violating and aiding and abetting violations of specified registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Van Horn consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The Complaint alleged, among other things, that Van Horn issued unqualified audit reports which were included in CoElco, Ltd's Form 10 and 1984 Annual Report, but conducted no substantive testing of information provided to him by CoElco and documented virtually none of his audit procedures; and at the time he executed the audit reports, Van Horn was not licensed as a certified public accountant. (SEC v. CoElco, Ltd., et al., USDC CDCA, Civil Action No. 86-7982 RMT, Kx). (LR-11903; AAER-206)

SPECIAL MASTER DISMISSED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on October 6 the Special Master appointed to make an accounting of client funds received by Jeffers, Lavelle, Maxwell & Associates Agency, Inc. and Dennis L. Jeffers were dismissed, after the Court considered the Report of the Special Master. The Report concluded that only about \$173,000 of the approximately \$3.1 million raised from the investment advisory clients of JLM and Jeffers remained. The funds were used primarily to make loans to inter-related groups and financially troubled companies, and to purchase stock of companies with no known market value. The Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief, entered on July 13, enjoining JLM and Jeffers from violating the antifraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of the Investment Advisers Act remains in effect. (SEC v. Dennis L. Jeffers, et al., USDC NDOH, Civil Action No. C88-2138). (LR-11905)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ISTITUTO MOBILIARE ITALIANO

An order has been issued exempting Istituto Mobiliare Italiano and IMI Commercial Paper, Inc. from all provisions of the Investment Company in connection with the issuance and sale in the United States of commercial paper notes, and at some time in the future, other debt securities by Applicants. (Rel. IC-16616 - Nov. 1)

KIDDER, PEABODY & CO. INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued extending the time period during which interested persons may comment on an application filed by Kidder, Peabody & Co. Incorporated, Kidder, Peabody Group Inc., and Webster Management Corporation for a temporary and permanent order exempting them from provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act. A notice was issued on October 6 [Rel. IC-16589] giving interested persons until October 31 to comment on the application for a permanent Section 9(c) order based on the information contained in certain reports filed under a temporary order issued on June 4, 1987. The Commission is extending the time period until November 25. (Rel. IC-16617 - Nov. 1)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY; NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until November 21 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24736, dated October 27: ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY (AP&L) - subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell, prior to February 28, 1991, up to \$270 million of its first mortgage bonds and up to \$150 million of its preferred stock by negotiated public offering or private placement. Subject to shareholder approval, AP&L will amend its Agreement of Consolidation or Merger to create a new class of its preferred stock, \$.01 par value, which will be priced on the basis of an assigned liquidation value; and NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM - a registered holding company, to issue and sell its common stock under its Employees' Share Ownership Plan; its Tax Deferred Savings Plan; and its Goals Program.
