PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 482

The Commission issued a release soliciting comment on proposed amendments to Rule 482 under the Securities Act. The proposed amendments to Rule 482 would permit certain advertisements that take the form of off-the-page prospectuses for mutual fund shares to include an order form for purchasing shares if the off-the-page prospectuses contain specified disclosure. Additionally, the release solicits comment on proposed new Form 482(g), which would be used as a cover sheet for certain filings required to be made under the proposed amendments, and on proposed amendments to Form N-1A, which would delete the instructions for summary prospectuses for mutual funds.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM SCHILLING III BARRED

The Commission instituted proceedings against William O. Schilling III (Schilling). The Order finds that on February 29, 1992 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois entered an order of permanent injunction against Schilling, a registered representative, with his consent and without his admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint except as to jurisdiction. The order enjoins him from violating Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. The complaint alleged that during the period from early 1987 to in or about February 1991. Schilling engaged in a fraudulent scheme involving investments in mutual funds and variable annuities. Specifically, Schilling, among other things, solicited at least \$530,000 from approximately 25 investors. He told the investors these funds would be used to purchase securities, consisting primarily of units in mutual funds and variable annuities. In reality, Schilling did not purchase securities, but instead used these funds to pay for his own personal expenses. In connection with this scheme, Schilling often induced the liquidation of other security positions.

The Commission's Order permanently bars Schilling from association with any regulated entity. [SEC v. William O. Schilling III and William O. Schilling III D/B/A William O. Schilling & Associates, Ltd., ND Ill., Eastern Division, Civil Action No. 93C507] (LR-13559)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TRO GRANTED AGAINST ROBERT DOVIK, ET AL.

The Commission announced that on March 12 the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas granted a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) against Robert F. Doviak, II (Doviak), Doviak Partners, Ltd. (Partners) and Doviak Securities, Inc. (DSI), a broker-dealer registered with the Commission. The TRO prohibits the defendants from violating the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and the net capital, books and records and notification rules of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and from dissipating any monies or property controlled by them.

As previously announced on March 4, the Commission filed a complaint alleging that Doviak and Partners violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer, purchase and sale of limited partnership interests in Partners. According to the complaint, Doviak diverted to himself and to DSI at least \$1 million of the \$4 million raised by Partners from investors since 1989. The complaint also alleges that DSI, aided and abetted by Doviak, violated the net capital, books and records and notification provisions of the federal securities laws. [SEC v. Robert F. The Commission approved on a temporary basis through December 31, 1993, a proposed rule change filed by The Intermarket Clearing Corporation (SR-ICC-92-01) that revises the standards for letters of credit which Clearing Members deposit as margin with ICC. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-32003)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-92-41) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange, which amends the PHLX's Schedule of Dues, Fees and Charges by eliminating the Transaction Value Charge and instituting the Option Comparison Charge, has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Option Comparison Charge imposes fees of \$.03 per contract for Registered Options Traders and \$.04 per contract for member organizations for their proprietary executions and those undertaken on behalf of their customers. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 22. (Rel. 34-32005)
