ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

MARTIN BROWNE PERMANENTLY SUSPENDED FROM PRACTICE BEFORE THE COMMISSION

Martin G. Browne, who holds himself out as a petroleum engineer, has been permanently suspended from practice before the Commission as an engineer, pursuant to Rule 2(e)(3)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. Browne prepared a false and misleading engineering report which, with Browne's consent, was relied on by the auditors of Cortez International, Ltd. and portions of which were incorporated into that company's Form 20-F which was filed with the Commission. Initially the Commission issued an Order of Temporary Suspension in accordance with Rule 2(e)(3)(i), based on the fact that a federal district court had permanently enjoined Browne from violating the federal securities laws (SEC v. Reynolds, CA#-91-1115-G, N.D. Tex., Mar. 24, 1993). In view of the fact that Browne did not petition the Commission for a hearing in this matter within 30 days after service of the Order of Temporary Suspension, the suspension has become permanent pursuant to Rule 2(e)(3)(ii). REMEDIAL SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST TALTON EMBRY

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act, made findings and imposed remedial sanctions against Talton R. Embry, the sole owner and chief executive officer of Magten Asset Management Corp., a registered investment adviser. Embry submitted an offer of settlement in which he consented to the entry of the Commission Order without admitting or denying the findings contained in the Order except for the finding that he has been permanently enjoined from violating and aiding and abetting violations of Section

10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; Sections 204, 206(1), 206(2), 206(3), and 207 of the Advisers Act; and Sections 17(a), 17(d) and 17(j) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 17d-1(a), 17j-1(a) and 17j-1(c) thereunder. In imposing remedial sanctions, the Commission recognized and credited assistance Embry provided to the Commission and the Office of the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York in an unrelated matter. It also found that, but for Embry's cooperation in the unrelated matter, more serious sanctions would have been imposed against Embry.

Generally, the Commission ordered that Embry shall retain an "Independent Consultant" who will recommend a compliance system and procedures that Embry must institute at Magten and any "Magten successor" (as defined in the Order) and audit Embry's personal securities transactions and the operations of Magten and any Magten successor biannually for five years. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CUSTODIAN OF RECORDS OF UNIVERSAL MEDIA, INC., DAVID JORDAN AND ELAINE JORDAN ORDERED TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY THEY SHOULD NOT BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH COMMISSION SUBPOENAS DUCES TECUM AND AD TESTIFICANDUM

The Commission announced that on September 13 the Honorable Shelby Highsmith, United States District Judge, entered an order requiring the Custodian of Records of Universal Media, Inc., David E. Jordan, and Elaine B. Jordan to produce all documents and to appear for testimony pursuant to Commission subpoenas duces tecum and ad testificandum previously issued and served upon them.

The Commission's Application for an Order to Show Cause and an Order Requiring Obedience to Subpoenas Duces Tecum and Ad Testificandum, filed on September 2, 1993, alleged that the above-named respondents, who reside and do business in Deerfield Beach, Florida, refused to produce documents and testify pursuant to lawfully issued Commission subpoenas. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED AGAINST 1ST AMERICAN CORPORATION, JOHN WOODS AND OTHERS

The Commission announced that on September 8 the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania issued a temporary restraining order against John Robert Woods (Woods), 1st American Corporation (1st American), G. Woods Mortgages and Approved Mortgage Corporation, all of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. The temporary restraining order prohibited the defendants from contacting potential investors for any investment device issued or proposed to be issued by the defendants and from soliciting or accepting any new investor funds.

The order follows a two-day contempt proceeding based on the Commission's claim that defendants Woods and 1st American violated a May 25, 1993, preliminary injunction order by engaging in additional fraudulent conduct. The court also granted the Commission's motion for leave to amend its original complaint, filed against the defendants on April 9, 1993, in which the Commission alleged that the defendants had misrepresented an investment product as a CMO. The Commission's amended complaint alleges that the defendants have since engaged in two additional fraudulent offerings of mortgage-backed securities and that the related solicitation materials contain misrepresentations and fail to disclose adequately the risks associated with the new investment products. Both parties must submit proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law on or before September 20, 1993 regarding the contempt motion. [SEC v. 1st American Corporation, et al., W.D. Pa., Civ. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HARTFORD LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 5, 1993 to request a hearing on an application filed by Hartford Life Insurance Company and Separate Account VL I of Hartford Life Insurance Company (together, Applicants) for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Section 27(a)(3) of the Act and Rule 6e-3(T)(b)(13)(ii) thereunder. The exemptions would apply to the extent necessary to permit Applicant to issue flexible premium variable life insurance policies that provide for a front-end sales load on premium payments made in any given year up to a maximum amount and no sales charge on premiums in excess of the amount. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 4, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company, a public-utility subsidiary company of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to sublease a portion of its storage capacity in the Merrill Creek Reservoir Project to a nonaffiliated company pursuant to a sublease agreement. NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 4, 1993 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company (NFG), a registered holding company, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (Distribution), a gas utility subsidiary company of NFG, and National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation (Supply), National Fuel Resources, Inc. (Resources), Seneca Resources Corporation (Seneca), and Empire Exploration, Inc. (Empire), each a wholly owned non-utility subsidiary company of NFG (the subsidiary companies collectively, Covered Subsidiaries). NFG proposes to

provide guarantees, through December 31, 1998, for a total of up to \$500 million of certain obligations of the Covered Subsidiaries, not to exceed the following amounts outstanding at any given time for each Covered Subsidiary: Distribution--\$350 million; Supply--\$50 million; Resources--\$50 million; Seneca--\$50 million; and Empire--\$10 million. THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY, ET AL.
