COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC TO HOST SMALL BUSINESS TOWN HALL MEETING IN SEATTLE, WA

The Commission today announced that a small business town hall meeting will be held at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 18, 1999 at the Hotel Monaco at 1101 Fourth Avenue, Seattle, Washington. The small business town hall meetings, which are being conducted throughout the United States, convey basic information to small business about fundamental requirements that must be addressed when these businesses wish to raise capital through the public sale of securities. In addition, the Commission hopes to learn more about the concerns and problems facing small businesses in raising capital so that programs can be designed to meet their needs, consistent with the protection of investors.

Brian J. Lane, Director of the Division of Corporation Finance, will be the featured speaker of the Seattle Small Business Town Hall Meeting, which is being co-sponsored by the Greater Seattle Chamber of Commerce and MIT Enterprise Forum of the Northwest. Other speakers include Lyn Hamilton, Deputy District Director for the Seattle District Office of the U.S. Small Business Administration, Deborah Bortner, Director of Securities for the Department of Financial Institutions for the State of Washington, and Steven Loyd, Chairman of the Northwest Capital Network. A question and answer period will follow the presentations.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CALVERT SOCIAL INVESTMENT FUND, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Calvert Social Investment Fund, et al. for an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits the implementation, without prior shareholder approval, of a new investment subadvisory agreement for a period beginning on January 15, 1999, and continuing through the date the subadvisory agreement is approved or disapproved by the shareholders of the investment company, but in no event longer than 90 days from January 15, 1999. PRINCIPAL MANAGEMENT CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 9, 1999, to request a hearing on an application filed by Principal Management Corporation, Principal Tax-Exempt Cash Management Fund, Inc. (Tax-Exempt Fund), and Principal Cash Management Fund, Inc. (Cash Management Fund). Applicants request an order under section 17(b) of the Act to permit the Cash Management Fund to acquire the assets and the liabilities of the Tax-Exempt Fund. (Rel. IC-23654 - January 15)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed change (SR-Phlx-98-38) that would assess a fee on persons who unsuccessfully contest an options ruling involving a trading dispute upon a finding that the appeal is frivolous. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-40936)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-98-36) to amend Rule 35 and adopt a new interpretation to Rule 35 relating to registration of floor employees. (Rel. 34-40943)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-98-35) relating to the Content Outline for the Trading Assistant Examination (Series 25). (Rel. 34-40944)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-NSCC-98-15) to require certain NSCC members to participate in the Security Industry Association's Year 2000 test to be conducted beginning in March 1999. The Commission approved the

proposed rule change on an accelerated basis. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-40946)
