COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC, NASD, AND NYSE TO CONVENE INDUSTRY SUMMIT TO ADDRESS AFTER-HOURS TRADING ISSUES

Chairman Arthur Levitt today announced that the SEC, the National Association of Securities Dealers, and the New York Stock Exchange will jointly convene a summit on June 30 to explore issues raised by after-hours trading.

Representatives of the industry, alternative trading systems, exchanges, clearing organizations, and consumer groups are scheduled to participate. Following the summit, the SEC, NASD, and the NYSE will select working group participants from a broad cross-section of the industry and other interested parties. (Press Rel. 99-69)

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO CANCEL REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN INVESTMENT ADVISERS

The Commission has issued a release amending its rules to delegate its authority to the Director of the Division of Investment Management to cancel the registration of any investment adviser that is not eligible for Commission registration. This amendment updates the staff's delegated authority to reflect recent amendments to the Investment Advisers Act, and is intended to conserve Commission resources by permitting the staff to cancel, when appropriate, the registration of investment advisers that are not eligible to be registered with the Commission. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

INSIDER TRADING CASE FILED AND SETTLED AGAINST DONALD WOHL

The Commission announced today that yesterday it filed and simultaneously settled an action in federal court in Los Angeles against Donald B. Wohl alleging insider trading in the securities of Koo Koo Roo, Inc. (Koo Koo Roo). The Commission's complaint alleges that Wohl, at the time a member of the company's board of directors, purchased stock in Koo Koo Roo before the company's March 30, 1998 announcement that Lee Iacocca would become Koo Koo Roo's acting chairman. The Commission's complaint alleges that Wohl purchased Koo Koo Roo stock for the accounts of five family members and clients. These accounts realized trading profits totaling \$65,280.

The Commission's complaint further alleges that Wohl violated a 1978 Commission order barring him from the securities industry. The Commission's complaint alleges that Wohl has provided securities advice to clients for compensation in violation of the Commission's previous order.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, Wohl consented to a final judgment against him. This judgment: (1) permanently enjoins Wohl from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; (2) permanently enjoins Wohl from association with a broker, dealer, investment adviser, or investment company; (3) requires Wohl to disgorge \$65,280 in insider trading profits plus prejudgment interest of \$3,066.80; and (4) requires Wohl to pay a civil penalty of \$65,280. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A memorandum opinion and order has been issued authorizing Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, to form subsidiaries (New Subsidiaries) to hold ownership interests in companies that are exempt wholesale generators, foreign utility companies, exempt telecommunications companies, energy-related companies, other New Subsidiaries and other nonutility businesses (collectively, Nonutility Companies). Entergy and the Nonutility Companies propose to issue, through December 31, 2002, guarantees in an aggregate amount up to \$750 million (Aggregate Authorization). The Nonutility Companies propose through December 31, 2002 to: (1) issue and sell securities to Entergy, other Nonutility Companies and nonassociate companies subject to the Aggregate Authorization; (2) pay dividends to their parent companies out of capital or unearned surplus; and (3) provide services to other Nonutility Companies at other than cost. ENTERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A memorandum opinion and order has been issued authorizing Entergy Corporation (Entergy), a registered holding company, its public-utility subsidiaries, its service company subsidiary, and some of its nonutility subsidiaries to implement an intrasystem pricing provision contemplated by settlement agreements among Entergy and its retail rate regulators in Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi and the City of New Orleans. The order also approves revised service agreements among Entergy's public-utility companies and its nonutility companies. (Rel. 35-27040)

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

Litigation Release No. 16193 / June 23, 1999

SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION v. DONALD B. WOHL, Civil Action No. CV 99-6354 DDP (SHx) (C.D. Cal.).

The Securities and Exchange Commission announced on June 23, 1999, that yesterday it filed and simultaneously settled an action in federal court in Los Angeles against Donald B. Wohl alleging insider trading in the securities of Koo Koo Roo, Inc. ("Koo Koo Roo"). The Commission's Complaint alleges that Wohl, at the time a member of the company's board of directors, purchased stock in Koo Koo Roo before the company's March 30, 1998 announcement that Lee Iacocca would become Koo Koo Roo's acting chairman. Koo Koo Roo stock was the most heavily-traded on United States securities markets that day. The price of Koo Koo Roo stock rose 71% on the news of the company's management change. The Commission's Complaint alleges that Wohl purchased Koo Koo Roo stock for the accounts of five family members and clients. These accounts realized trading profits totaling \$65,280.

The Commission's Complaint further alleges that Wohl violated a previous Commission order barring him from the securities industry. In 1978, Wohl consented to the entry of an order which barred him from acting as or associating with a broker, dealer, investment adviser, or investment company. The Commission's Complaint alleges that Wohl has provided securities advice to clients for compensation in violation of the Commission's 1978 order.

Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, Wohl consented to a final judgment against him. This judgment: (1) permanently enjoins Wohl from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; (2) permanently enjoins Wohl from association with a broker, dealer, investment adviser, or investment company; (3) requires Wohl to disgorge \$65,280 in insider trading profits plus prejudgment interest of \$3,066.80; and (4) requires Wohl to pay a civil penalty of \$65,280.
