

Creating an ESI Toolbar

After you have saved the uncompressed DLL files to your hard drive, launch ArcMap.

To install the ESI Toolbar on the ArcMap toolbar:

1. Right-click on the ArcMap toolbar and scroll down to Customize (or choose the Customize option under the Tools menu).
2. Select the Toolbars tab on the Customize window.
3. On the right side, click the "New button" option.
4. In the New Toolbar dialog box, name the toolbar "ESI Tools". Choose Normal.mxt in the "Save in" option, and you will be able to turn the ESI Toolbar on and off from any ArcMap document.

Once the toolbar is created, you need to add the ESI tools:

1. Select the Commands tab on the Customize window.
2. Click the "Add from file" button. Navigate to the ESI DLL files on your hard drive. Select one of the files and click Open to add it to your available commands. Click OK.
3. Click the icon next to the ESI tool and drag it onto the ESI Toolbar. Release the mouse button when your cursor becomes a vertical bar. (You need to release the mouse button at or before the last icon on your toolbar.)
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 for all of the ESI DLL files.
5. Exit the Customize window.
