## **Tour operators versus Travel Agencies**

In Germany there are roughly 16,277 (FVW 05/14/05) travel agencies, which are intermediaries who sell tour operator packages to consumers for commission. Thus, U.S. tourism product suppliers should provide varying discounted rates to tour operators passing on commission to travel agents.

## **Consumer Protection and German Travel Law**

German Tour operators are liable to deliver the package promised under German Consumer Protection and German Travel Law. Since 1994, German tour operators must offer the client proof in the form of a written guarantee that the package holiday price plus any return journey costs incurred in the event of bankruptcy are covered by a bank guarantee or insurance. German travel law also states that the tour operator is obliged to present the trip exactly as described in the brochure. In addition, this law holds German tour operators accountable for services provided by them through foreign agents. If, through the fault of the tour operator or its agents, the client is not satisfied with or does not receive the service contracted, the client may sue the tour operator for damages.
