## MEDIA BUREAU ANNOUNCES EFFECTIVE DATE FOR RULES ADOPTED IN DTV DELAY ACT OMNIBUS ORDER AND COMMENT DATE FOR NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING MB DOCKET NO. 09-17

Comments Due: March 4, 2009

On February 20, 2009, the Commission adopted and released a *Second Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rule Making* ("*DTV Delay Act Omnibus Order*")<sup>1</sup> to implement the most time sensitive of the remaining actions necessitated by the delay in the digital television transition deadline.<sup>2</sup> By this Public Notice, the Media Bureau announces the effective date of the rules adopted in the *DTV Delay Act Omnibus Order* to implement the DTV Delay Act and the comment date of the companion *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*.

The *DTV Delay Act Omnibus Order* was published today in the Federal Register.<sup>3</sup> Accordingly, the rules adopted in the *DTV Delay Act Omnibus Order* are now in effect,<sup>4</sup> except for the following rules, which will take effect on April 1, 2009: 47 C.F.R. §§ 15.124, 54.418, and 76.1630.<sup>5</sup> Additionally, the revised Forms 387 and 388 are available now on the FCC Form Page.<sup>6</sup>

The companion *NPRM* was also published today in the Federal Register.<sup>7</sup> Accordingly, comments must be filed on or before March 4, 2009. The *NPRM* set an expedited, one-round comment cycle of five (5) calendar days after publication in the Federal Register.<sup>8</sup> The Commission found that the five-day comment period (with no reply period) provided the maximum possible opportunity for public comment that would still enable it to fulfill the statutory mandate to take such actions as are necessary or appropriate to implement the DTV Delay Act and accomplish its purposes within 30 days of the DTV Delay Act's enactment, *i.e.*, no later than March 13, 2009.<sup>9</sup> Commenters must follow the filing instructions provided in paragraphs 75-77 of the *NPRM*.<sup>10</sup>
