COMMISSIONER ADELSTEIN TO VISIT LOS ANGELES FOR DTV OUTREACH Visit is Part of Extensive Nationwide Tour Focusing on Markets with High Levels of Over-the-Air Television Viewers

Washington, DC – FCC Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein announced that he will visit Los Angeles, CA, to hold three public events on the digital television (DTV) transition.
