



Brown's Farm Trail - is accessed from the Owens Creek Picnic Area off of Foxville-Deerfield Road. There are picnic tables, grills, and a restroom provided in this picnic area. The trailhead is located next to the first parking area on the right.

Brown's Farm Trail is an interpretive/environmental study area that takes visitors through wetlands, a pine grove, Brown's Farm ruins, an eastern hardwood forest, and across a mountain stream. The trail finishes on the back side of the picnic area.

Suitable for all ages, this trail offers a great opportunity for hike, lunch combinations. As visitors follow the interpretive guide brochure (obtained at trailhead or Visitor Center) they will be amazed at the diversity of the forest and see first hand the ruins left behind by some of the first settlers.
