

Railway Infrastructure Opportunities In 2009

On December 2, CS Egypt organized major project briefing on opportunities in the Railways Infrastructure sector for U.S. companies at the AmCham. Representatives from more than 50 American companies attended the briefing. The briefing focused on Egypt National Railways Restructuring Project (ENRRP) encompassing new rail lines in Cairo-10th of Ramadan City, Alexandria-Borg El Arab, Cairo-6th of October City, as well as Station Commercialization in Alexandria (Misr Station), Sidi Gaber, Tanta, Ramses, Giza, Luxor, and Aswan.

CS Egypt Launches A Series Of "Doing Business With America" Seminars

CS Egypt joined hands with Tenth of Ramadan and Sixth of October Investors' Associations to organize two "Doing Business with America" seminars on October 16, and November 25, 2008 respectively. Ambassador Scobey delivered the keynote speech to an audience of more than 75 business people at each event followed by a presentation on doing business with US and the US business visa procedures.

CS Egypt Continues To Promote Medical Standards

On December 3-4, CS Egypt in collaboration with U.S. Pharmacopeia and PhRMA, organized the second Annual Scientific meeting in Cairo. The Ambassador opened the conference which presented medicine standards topics of interest to industry scientists engaged in the manufacture, quality assurance and quality control of pharmaceutical and biotechnology products. This conference gave the Egyptian Ministry of Health a first-hand look at the U.S. system of standardization in medicines.

Second International Franchise Expo

CS Egypt is organizing the second International Franchise Expo that will take place in Cairo on April 7 and 8. The Franchise Expo has two main objectives. First, to support the expansion of the franchise industry to effectively contribute to sustainable economic growth in Africa and the Middle East. Second, to introduce American franchisors and Master licensees to significant opportunities to expand their businesses in the booming African and Middle Eastern markets.

CS Egypt Continues To Promote "Study USA" Initiative

CS Egypt hosted a Community College Catalog show in Cairo for approximately 700 students attended the fair. CS Egypt also counseled more than 400 graduate and undergraduate students at the Academia Global Education Fair about study opportunities in the United States. CS Egypt continued it education blitz during the International study week Nov 21 – 25 during which CS Egypt held a seminar on graduate studies in the U.S. More than 150 students attended the session.

CS EGYPT PARTICIPATES IN AVEX AIRSHOW 2008

CS Egypt represented the U.S. Embassy at the Egyptian Ministry of Civil Aviation's 3rd International Air Show and Exposition AVEX.
