ORDER GRANTING MOTION

TO EXCEED PAGE LIMITATION

UNDER RULE 250(c)

The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued its Order Instituting Proceedings in this matter on December 5, 2000. On December 16, 2005, the Division of Enforcement (Division) filed a motion for summary disposition against Respondent Salvatore DiAmbrosio (DiAmbrosio) and a concurrent motion for leave to file a motion for summary disposition in excess of thirty-five pages. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.250(a), (c). The motion for summary disposition consists of a total of fifty-eight pages, including attachments: (1) a memorandum in support of the motion for summary disposition (sixteen pages); (2) the criminal indictment (twelve pages); (3) preliminary instructions to the jury (nineteen pages); (4) the jury verdict (one page); (5) the criminal judgment (seven pages); and (6) a declaration concerning prejudgment interest (three pages). DiAmbrosio did not file an opposition against either motion. See 17 C.F.R. § 201.154(b).

Since the majority of the pages in the fifty-eight-page motion for summary disposition are criminal documents relevant to this proceeding, the Division's request to exceed the thirty-five-page limit set forth in Rule 250(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice is GRANTED.
