Trail Notes

- 1 Sidewalks on Sibley and Jackson Streets connect Upper and Lower Landing Park with downtown Saint Paul. The Mississippi National River and Recreation Area Headquarters, Kellogg Park, and the Mississippi River Visitor Center in the Science Museum of Minnesota are all west on Kellogg Boulevard.
- 2 From Upper Landing Park take Eagle Street (Old Chestnut Street) to Kellogg Boulevard. Head east on Kellogg for the National Park Service's Mississippi River Visitor Center located in the Science Museum of Minnesota.
- 3 The 1.25-mile Lower Landing Trail concludes at the eastern end, although sidewalks continue and connect with Battle Creek Regional Park and Indian Mounds Park. The sidewalk follows Warner Road across two busy exit and entrance ramps before joining the path that links the parks. Use caution when crossing.
- 4 The Wabasha Street Bridge has dedicated on-road bike lanes, both northbound and southbound on their respective sides of the bridge. There are ramps leaving the bridge on its south end that connect to trails running along Water Street.
