## Patricia Kicklighter named Superintendent of Assateague Island National Seashore



Kicklighter is a native Missourian, and graduated from Southwest Missouri State University with a bachelor's degree in Wildlife Conservation and Management. She met her husband Wayne while they both worked at Ozark National Scenic Riverways.

About Assateague Island National Seashore: Established in 1965 as a unit of the National Park Service, Assateague Island National Seashore boasts a dynamic 37 mile long barrier island including 39,723 acres of land, several smaller marsh islands and an even larger expanse of water resources just off the coasts of Maryland and Virginia. Within the boundaries of the seashore, visitors encounter Maryland's most popular state park and a national wildlife refuge. Assateague Island National Seashore provides a protected enclave for complex plant and animal communities, both terrestrial and aquatic, which characterize the mid-Atlantic coast, and fully illustrates the natural processes of change which is constantly shaping the coastal environment.
