## American Foundation for the Blind Motion for Extension of Reply Comment Deadline

At the present time no reliable access technology exists which can enable a blind user to access this format. As a result these filings are not available in an equivalent accessible format which makes it impossible to review them and file reply comments in the current schedule. For this reason, AFB respectfully requests that the Commission extend the reply comment deadlines in the manner specified above.
