FOREWARD

Public Law 93-400 requires that the Office of Management and Budget (OMB),Office of Federal Procurement Policy (OFPP), "...establish a system for collecting, developing, and disseminating the procurement data which takes into account the needs of the Congress, the executive branch, and the public sector. Under the guidance of OFPP, design of the Federal Procurement Data System (FPDS) was completed in early 1978 and data collection began October 1, 1978. The Federal Procurement Data Center (FPDC) was established to operate the system. The Center provides a central point to respond to the requirements of the legislative, executive, and judicial branches of the Government as well as the private sector.

The Federal Procurement Data Center produces reports which examine various aspects and impacts of the Federal acquisition process. The data can be used for geographical analysis, market analysis, and analysis of the impact of congressional and presidential initiatives in socio-economic areas such as small business. The data is also a reliable basis for measuring and assessing the impact of Federal acquisition policy and management improvement.

Basic acquisition data will be published each fiscal year in the Federal Procurement Report. Special reports to meet specific data requirements can be produced on demand. Data on each procurement action of fiscal year 2000 is available on CD-ROM.



FEDERAL PROCUREMENT HISTORY BY QUARTER


Actions Reported Individually on SF279 Fiscal Year 2000 Through Fourth Quarter

HIGHLIGHTS

The FPDS Federal Procurement Report is published annually, and contains "snapshot" statistics on the procurement activities of over 60 agencies. The figures in this report are only as accurate, timely and complete as the data provided by the reporting agencies to the FPDC.

All dollars are in thousands except for the dollars in the Credit Card report and the per capita procurement displayed at the top of each State Snapshot. Due to rounding, dollars on the charts may not equal the TOTAL DOLLAR figure, and percentages may not total 100 percent.

The FPDS Federal Procurement Report is current as of the date of issuance and all order reports are obsolete, therefore, the FPDC will not maintain prior issuances for either distribution or for reference.

The "Commodity Futures Trading Commission" and "Commission on Civil Rights" did not report in fiscal year 2000 and are not displayed in this report. The "National Capital Planning Commission, U.S. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency, and U.S. Information Agency" have been abolished. A new agency, the "Broadcasting Board of Governors", has been added to the report.

The Report on Annual Procurement Preference Goaling Achievements contains fiscal year 2000 dollars that were processed in April of 2001. The figures in the "Goaling" report may not match the figures in the agency snapshot reports due to various exclusions.






CONTRACT DOLLARS BY EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

CIVILIAN AGENCIES TOTAL DOLLLARS \$71.4 BILLION




DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE TOTAL DOLLARS \$132.1 BILLION




