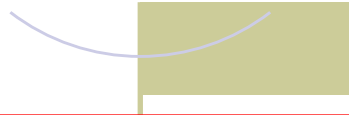

## Shelter Exercise

On Wednesday, April 22, employees from the Health Department, DSS, and Emergency Services, along with volunteers from the American Red Cross and the Salvation Army participated in a shelter exercise at the First Baptist Church on South Church Street in Asheboro.

113 Church members volunteered to be shelter residents and were registered into the shelter by DSS and Public Health employees. It is important that each person is thoroughly screened for any special needs they may have while staying in a shelter.

Shelter residents were taken to classrooms where they participated in brief disaster related discussions with counselors from Therapeutic Alternatives. The Salvation Army set up its canteen and provided all of the participants with a nice barbeque dinner.

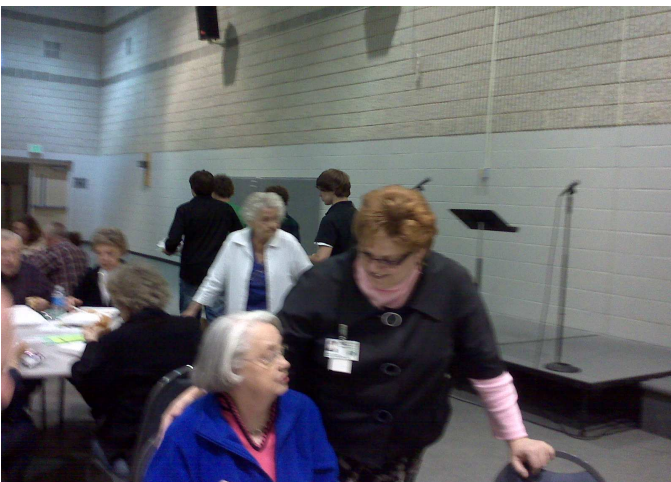
D-0 = Abnormally Dry Conditions (Yellow shaded areas)
