ORDER UNDER SECTION 61(a)(3)(B) OF THE INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT OF 1940

Medallion Financial Corp. filed an application on May 10, 2006, and an amendment to the application on July 30, 2007, requesting an order under section 61(a)(3)(B) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the "Act") approving applicant's 2006 stock option plan for directors who are not also employees or officers of applicant (the "Plan") and the grant of certain stock options thereunder.

On July 30, 2007, a notice of the filing of the application was issued (Investment Company Act Release No. 27917). The notice gave interested persons an opportunity to request a hearing and stated that an order granting the application would be issued unless a hearing was ordered. No request for a hearing has been filed, and the Commission has not ordered a hearing.

The matter has been considered and it is found, on the basis of the information set forth in the application, as amended, that the terms of the proposal to issue options under the Plan are fair and reasonable and do not involve overreaching of applicant or its shareholders.

Accordingly, in the matter of Medallion Financial Corp. (File No. 812-13290)

IT IS ORDERED, under section 61(a)(3)(B) of the Act, that the requested authorization is granted, effective immediately.
