Working in areas abundant with Wildlife, the following etiquette should be followed:

- Wildlife + Stress decrease winter fat reserves, please be considerate not to pursue activities that cause animals to exert unneeded energy reserves.
- Activities that cause stress include stopping your vehicle to get a better look at the animals or driving at excessive speeds.
- Stay in your car.
 - View animals from a distance.
- Keep dogs out of areas that wildlife are using during winter months. Even a dog on a leash, or at a distance, is viewed as a predator by wildlife.
- When driving lease roads, animals get the Right-of –Way.
- Respect winter habitat closures, they are in place for the good of the animals.

Help to preserve our wildlife Care enough to prevent them harm.
